ARAZI TO JAPAN U.S. and European champion Arazi (Blushing Groom {Fr}), who swept to the forefront of American racing with a breathtaking stretch run to capture the 1991 Gl Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Downs, has been sold to the Thoroughbred Breeders' Club of Japan and will ship to that country to stand in 1998. Now eight, the stallion began his stud career at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, England, then moved to Three Chimneys Farm for the 1997 season, where he stood for a fee of \$30,000, live foal. "We are sorry to lose the horse," said Three Chimneys owner Robert N. Clay, "but we feel fortunate to have stood Arazi in 1997, and to be anticipating at least one North American crop by him." Arazi won nine of his 14 career starts and retired with earnings of \$1,300,206.

KEENELAND OPENS TODAY The GI Queen Elizabeth Il Challenge Cup headlines this afternoon's opening-day card at historic Keeneland Racecourse in Lexington, Kentucky. The \$400,000 mile-and-an-eighth event for three-year-old turf fillies is the first of 17 stakes worth a total of nearly \$3 million scheduled for the 16-day meeting. Also on tap this season are the \$500,000-added GI Three Chimneys Spinster S. for fillies and mares October 12, the \$400,000-added Gll Walmac International Alcibiades for two-year-old fillies October 11 and the \$400,000-added GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity October 18 for two-year-olds, which is expected to draw the undefeated division leader, Favorite Trick (Phone Trick). "We're delighted to be in a position to offer the kind of purse structure that we've put together for this fall's meeting," said Keeneland President William C. Greely. "Obviously, the higher the purse structure, the better chance you have of attracting the top Thoroughbreds in the country and we certainly expect to have outstanding racing." In addition, Keeneland will showcase a list of improvements which includes the remodeling of the Blue Grass Room adjacent to the third floor of the grandstand, expanded parking, a new sprinkler system, and diaper changing tables in all restrooms--both ladies' and gentlemen's. The Keeneland Fall meet runs Wednesdays through Sundays until October 25. First post is 1:10 p.m.

S. at Arlington last out August 24.
