PEINTRE CELEBRE BESTS ELDERS IN ARC

WIN French Derby hero **Peintre Celebre** (Nureyev) rallied from 12th in yesterday's 18-horse Prix de l' Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, France, to take Europe's middle-distance championship race in track-record time. The colt shattered Trempolino's 1987 stakes and track record by almost 1 1/2 seconds to give his 80-year-old owner and breeder Daniel Wildenstein and trainer Andre Fabre their fourth victory in the race. With half the race run, Peintre Celebre looked beaten as he raced well back and first **Busy Flight (GB)** (Pharly {Fr}) and then 1996 Arc winner **Helissio (Fr)** (Fairy King) set a strong pace. Once in the stretch, Helissio tried to get away from the field, as he had done last year, but once Olivier Peslier had weaved his way through the field on Peintre Celebre, the race was settled in a few strides and the only three-year-old colt in the field quickened brilliantly to go clear by five lengths. Helissio found nothing extra in the closing stages and finished a tired sixth, while **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent), came out of the pack to finish second for the second straight year and German Derby-winning filly **Borgia (Ger)** (Acatenango) flew home for third. "This horse is very special," said Fabre. "He is a good Classic winner and is now the leading horse in Europe, having beaten all these good older horses. You cannot ask anything more of a horse. I admit I was worried as they were going downhill. I had hoped he would be a little closer to the lead, but the pace was very hot. He got himself out of trouble with brilliant acceleration and suddenly he was in the clear." Peslier, winning his second straight Arc said, "I was never worried, even when we dropped back to 12th. This horse is always a bit lazy early on. He needs time to find his stride and at the top of the straight he quickened brilliantly and really took off. He has a great temperament and a great turn of foot."

At the top of the hill HELISSIO (FR) (Fairy King) led from BUSY FLIGHT (GB) (Pharly {Fr}), SWAIN (IRE) (Nashwan) and PREDAPPIO (GB) (Polish Precedent) and that order was maintained down the false straight while Peintre Celebre was forced to make his move from 12th in the 18-horse field. Down the stretch, Peintre Celebre burst through to take the lead and quickly opened up his advantage. Pilsudski (Ire) came on late to grab the place spot and Borgia (Ger) checked in third, just ahead of the Irish St. Leger winner OSCAR SCHINDLER (IRE) (Royal Academy). Pilsudski's trainer Michael Stoute, who may send the five-year-old to Hollywood Park for the Breeders' Cup Turf on November 8, said: "There was one horse too many in this race!" The runner-up's rider Michael Kinane added: "He ran a marvellous race, but, like last year, he found one too good." Elie Lellouche, trainer of last year's Arc hero Helissio, said of his colt's sixth-place showing, "The horse was not fresh enough. It wasn't possible to keep him on the top of his game for 12 months. He has never had a break since last year's Arc. He had a hard race in the King George at Ascot (July 26) and also in the Prix du Moulin (September 7). He ran like a tired horse."

Making only her second start, Loving Claim maintained her unbeaten record with a superb front-running effort to claim this prize and establish herself as the 6-1 second favorite for next year's English 1000 Guineas. She led from the gate and entering the stretch quickened brilliantly to go clear and only tiredness in the closing stages enabled Isle De France, winner of a minor stake in the French Provinces September 6, to close on her. Trainer Criquelette Head said, "I always thought she was very good and now she's proven it today. She is a possible for the English 1000 Guineas next year, but she is also bred to stay further than a mile. She will now be rested until next season."

On only her second start this year, having run third in a stake at Doncaster September 10, Carmine Lake (Ire) had too much in reserve in the closing stages for her rivals, powering home from the speedy Pas De Reponse. The win, Carmine Lake's third win from only seven lifetime starts, gave trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam his second Group 1 win at the meet, following Chief Contender in Saturday's Prix du Cadran. Chapple-Hyam said: "This is unbelievable, but I did fancy her a lot, as she has been in superb form at home. She's had a quiet season because she suffers from arthritis in her knees and you have to take care of her. I knew she could quicken and when (jockey) John Reid pulled her out, I knew she could win." Pas de Reponse's trainer Criquelette Head indicated her filly will start next in the Nov. 8 Breeders' Cup Sprint.

Real Connection, winless in 17 starts since taking the Aug. 24, 1996 Osunitas H. at Del Mar, came into this effort off of a fifth-place outing in the Aug. 31 GII Chula Vista H. over the main Del Mar track. Back on the turf here, the grey mare settled behind the early leaders, moved three wide into the stretch and wore down Toda Una Dama (Arg) in a determined stretch drive. "It's Sunday, and at the sixteenth pole, I was doing a lot of praying," admitted winning trainer Mel Stute. "She always makes you think you've got a chance, but when I looked up...I thought she was going to hang again. They invited us to the race in New York yesterday (the Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont Park) and I didn't want to ship her. So I thought we should stay here because it would be easier. And then there's a horse they paid \$2 million-something for (Luna Wells). I didn't tell her (Real Connection) how much they paid for that one."

Only a half-hour after his fourth Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe victory, Andre Fabre saddled French Jockey Club President Jean-Luc Lagardere's homebred filly Clodora (Fr) to capture her first graded stake and her third win from seven starts this year. The filly made her move through the field early in the stretch, caught Squeak (GB) entering the final eighth-of-a-mile and took command for a comfortable success.
