**ALHAARTH RETIRED** It was announced Monday that Godolphin's four-year-old colt **Alhaarth (Ire)** (Unfuwain--Irish Valley, by Irish River {Fr}), wire-to-wire winner of Saturday's G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp, has been retired to stud. Champion Juvenile in Europe in 1995 after an unbeaten run of five wins, including the G1 Generous Dewhurst S., Alhaarth won only once as a three-year-old, capturing the G2 Prix du Rond-Point at Longchamp. Earlier this year he was runner-up to Bosra Sham in the G2 Prince Of Wales's S. at Ascot and then won the G2 Sea World International S. at The Curragh. Winner of eight of his 17 lifetime starts, Alhaarth earned \$592,941. He retires to Derrinstown Stud in Ireland, owned by his breeder Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum, in whose colors he raced at ages two and three. His former trainer Major Dick Hern said, "He was brilliant and precocious two-year-old, but didn't find his best form as a three-year-old."

### RISEN STAR COLT TOPS \$650,000 AT ARC

**SALE** Goffs France held its annual Arc Sale of Horses in Training Saturday night, the evening before the 1997 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Bringing top price of \$656,114 was **Lord Cromby (Ire)** (Risen Star), runner-up behind Alhaarth in Saturday afternoon's G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp. The three-year-old colt was purchased by Michel Zerolo (Oceanic Bloodstock) and will be trained by Bobby Frankel toward the G1 Hollywood Derby November 30. The second highest price of the sale was fetched by **Titus Livius (Fr)** (Machiavellian), who went on to run sixth in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp. The four-year-old still ran in the Niarchos colors Sunday after being sold for \$492,086 Saturday night, though the deal included any prize money won being split with new owner Narvick International. Titus Livius, winner of this year's G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly and a pair of graded stakes at age two, will now join trainer Wally Dollase's barn in California. Overall, 25 horses in training sold for a gross of \$2,656,606 and an average of \$106,264, up 67.6 percent from last year's average of \$63,403.

**GOFFS ORBY SALE BEGINS TODAY** The 1997 Goffs Orby Select Yearling Sale will be held today and Wednesday at Goffs Ireland's Kildare Paddocks and will be followed Thursday by an additional offering of 250 yearlings--the only horses eligible for the Goffs £100,000 Challenge in June next year. The Orby Sale sold the world's highest-priced yearling in 1996, a colt by Woodman--Danse Royale (Ire), who was purchased by Demi O'Byrne, agent, for \$1,906,780. This year's catalog includes a half-brother to last year's sales topper by Kingmambo and 16 yearlings by Sadler's Wells, including half-brothers to Group 1 winners White Muzzle (GB), Moonax (Ire) and Dolphin Street (Fr). Major 1997 winners who are Goffs Ireland sales graduates include Lexus Irish 2,000 Guineas and Budweiser Irish Derby winner Desert King (Ire), G1 Darley July Cup hero Compton Place (Ire) and G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. victor First Island (Ire).

**ARC HEROES TO SKIP BREEDERS' CUP** **Peintre Celebre** (Nureyev) and **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent), the one-two finishers in Sunday's Arc de Triomphe, are both expected to pass the Nov. 8 Breeders' Cup Turf. Reached yesterday, trainer Andre Fabre said that Peintre Celebre, who beat Pilsudski by five lengths in the Arc, is likely to be rested for the rest of the year before returning next year as a four-year-old. "The chances that he will run in the Breeders' Cup are really remote because he will stay in training as a four-year-old," Fabre said. "He's not tired, but he has had a nice campaign this year and the Breeders' Cup would just be icing on the cake. If we keep him in training, it makes more sense to go for the Breeders' Cup next year." Pilsudski won last year's Turf, but will not be back to defend his title. "Pilsudski won't be going to California for the Breeders' Cup, but he could go to the Japan Cup," trainer Michael Stoute told the *Racing Post*.

**OBS FALL MIXED SALE STARTS OFF STRONG**

The Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's 1997 Fall Mixed Sale kicked off yesterday with the first of two consignor preferred sessions. A total of 170 horses sold for a gross of \$2,476,500 and an average of \$14,568, an 88 percent increase over the 1996 first session average of \$7,752. The median price rose 130 percent from \$5,000 last year to \$11,500 in 1997. A pair of eight-year-old broodmares shared honors for the day's highest price, each selling for \$75,000. **Tune in to the Cat** (Tunerup), consigned by Hilmer C. Schmidt's Indian Hill Farm, was purchased by Gardner F. Landon. She is the dam of Gill What a Pleasure S. winner Cat On Tour, and is currently in foal to Cat On Tour's sire Tour d'Or. Jacks or Better Farm bought **Miss Tanya** (Coastal)--in foal to Phone Trick--from the Warnerton, LTD. consignment. The day's highest priced weanling was hip number 197, a colt from the first crop by graded stakes winner **Boone's Mill** (Carson City). Consigned by Thoroughstock, Agent VII, the chestnut colt sold to Lucas Farm for \$62,000. "We're off to an excellent start," said OBS Director of Sales Tom Ventura. "The catalog is much stronger than last year and the demand was strong at all levels of the market for broodmares as well as for weanlings." The OBS Fall Mixed Sale continues today at 10:30 a.m. with the second consignor preferred session.

**HONOR GRADES TO DARBY DAN Honor Grades**

(Danzig--Weekend Surprise, by Secretariat) will stand the 1998 breeding season at Darby Dan Farm in Lexington, Kentucky, according to Emmanuel de Seroux, principal of Narvick International, Inc. Narvick will continue to act as Syndicate Manager for the stallion. Nine-year-old Honor Grades, who formerly stood at Bonnie Heath Farm in Ocala, Florida, is out of Broodmare of the Year Weekend Surprise and is a half-brother to Preakness winner Summer Squall and Horse of the Year A.P. Indy. He is the sire of GI Secretariat S. winner Honor Glide and additional stakes winners His Honor and Command Post (NZ).
