STRONG GOFFS SALE ENDS Continuing the frenetic pace of its first two days, the Goffs Irish National Yearling Sale concluded vesterday in Kildare. Ireland with the Two-Year-Old Challenge Sale. At the session, 226 yearlings--all eligible for next summer's Goffs Challenge at the Curragh--sold for a total of \$4,492,984 and an average of \$19,880. The day's high price was paid for hip number 497. The filly, by Fairy King--More Fizz (GB) (Morston {Fr}) was consigned by Ciaran Conroy's Glenvale Stud in Tipperary and brought a final bid of \$168,294. Bloodstock agent Gordian Troeller signed the purchase docket on behalf of trainer Gaye Kelleway. During the three-day sale, 667 horses sold for a total of \$42,824,180 and an average of \$72,830. The aggregate marked an increase of 20.6 percent from last year's sale and the average rose 13.6 percent. Goffs Managing Director Philip Myerscough said, "It has been a tremendously strong sale and at no point during the three days did the momentum flag. We have had all the main buyers present and our policy of keeping numbers tight has been rewarded. Vendors have expressed great confidence in our sale structure."

TURFWAY WRAP-UP The 23-day 1997 Fall Meet at Turfway Park, which ended October 3, showed a continuing decline in on-track numbers but a slight increase in total handle. On-track handle dipped 25 percent, from \$14,650,916 in 1996 to \$10,983,361 in 1997; the daily average handle on-track was also down 25 percent, from \$636,996 to \$477,537. Ontrack attendance was off 23 percent, from 71,989 last year to 55,517 this year. The daily average attendance went from 3,130 to 2,414. But, boosted by a jump in inter-track, off-track and out-of-state wagering, total handle showed a four-percent increase, rising from \$80,727,268 to \$83,862,968; the daily average total handle increased from \$3,509,881 to \$3,646,216. "Our on-track business continues to struggle," said Turfway Park President Mark Simendinger. "Our continued downward trend ontrack shows that the two area river boats, both located within 30 minutes of Turfway, are having a direct impact on our business levels. The good out-ofstate figures are gratifying, but don't come close to replacing the lost on-track revenues."

CLAIBORNE CONSIGNMENT TO HEADLINE **KEENELAND JANUARY** Dissolving the partnership begun by Bull Hancock and William Haggin Perry nearly 40 years ago, Claiborne Farm will offer some of the most sought-after bloodlines in racing at the 1998 Keeneland January Sale. Explaining the reason for the dispersal of the bloodstock owned jointly by the Paris, Kentucky farm and Nicole Perry Gorman, Claiborne's Dell Hancock said, "Mr. Perry loved the game, he loved breeding the horses he owned. Nicole enjoys racing, but it's a very big commitment. We hope and expect that sometime down the road, when the dust settles, she'll buy a few yearlings. We also hope that when she does, she'll buy them with us. This was a very amicable parting," Included in the 35horse consignment are top broodmares such as Bound (Nijinsky II), in foal to Seeking the Gold; Eaves (Cox's Ridge), in foal to Mr. Prospector; GSW Edge (Damascus), dam of MGSW Boundary, in foal to Unbridled; and Wisla (Danzig), in foal to Private Terms. There will also be 12 1998 yearlings, including a colt by Mr. Prospector out of Video (Nijinsky II), making him a full brother to MGISW Scan; a filly by Nashwan out of Bound: and a filly by Seeking the Gold out of MGSW Number (Nijinsky II) who is a half sister to G1SW Jade Robbery (Mr. Prospector), GSW Numerous (Mr. Prospector) and GSW Chequer (Mr. Prospector). Among the eight 1998 two-year-olds to be sold are a filly by Mr. Prospector out of Department (Secretariat); a colt by Forty Niner out of Kashan (Damascus), a half-brother to GSW Herat (Northern Dancer) and MSW Tile (Honest Pleasure); and a filly by Seeking the Gold out of Number. "Not much of these bloodlines have gone out of the hands of the partnership," said Hancock. "They have been pretty closely held. It's a great opportunity to buy bloodlines that are not usually on the market. We've sold a lot of good horses out of these mares."

**BLUE ENSIGN TOPS FINAL OBS SESSION The** Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's 1997 Fall Mixed Sale ended in strong fashion Thursday in Ocala, Florida, with the second of two open sessions. A total of 184 horses sold yesterday for a gross of \$1,102,100, an average of \$5,990 and a median price of \$4,200. The average was up 33 percent from \$4,491 in 1996 while the median price increased 40 percent from \$3,000 a year ago. The final session's topper was hip number 975, a filly by Blue Ensign--Flip for Luck, by Flip Sal. Consigned by Red Sunset Farm, agent, the half sister to stakes winning Halos and Horns (Saint Ballado) brought a final bid of \$70,000 from Mac Mt. Thoroughbreds, agent for Richard Spoor. During the three-day sale, 714 horses grossed \$6,818,300, more than double the 1996 gross of \$3,302,200. The average price rose 73 percent from \$5,504 to \$9,549, while the median price jumped to \$6,000. "There's no doubt the catalog was stronger than last year's and I thought the market remained strong right through the end of the sale," said OBS President Tom Chiota. "There was no shortage of buyers in all price ranges and it was good to see so many new people buying horses here in Ocala."

MILLKOM RETIRED Millkom (GB) (Cyrano de Bergerac), winner of the 1995 GI Man o' War and the highweight three-year-old in France at 9.5-11 furlongs in 1994, has been retired from racing after reinjuring his right fore tendon. The six-year-old was off nearly two years after his Man o' War win and returned to finish third in his final start the Live the Dream H. at Del Mar Sept. 10. He had been training up to Sunday's GI Oak Tree Turf Championship and a possible Breeders' Cup Turf start when he was injured. Millkom retires with 12 wins from 19 starts and earnings of \$712,078.


