### TOUCH GOLD GLITTERS AT HOLLYWOOD

Breezing for the first time since his disappointing last-place finish in the GII Buick Pegasus H. at the Meadowlands September 20, **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) worked five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 at Hollywood Park yesterday morning. With exercise rider Augie Munoz in the saddle, the three-year-old cruised through fractions of :25 3/5, :37 3/5 and :49 2/5; he galloped out six furlongs in 1:13. "He usually doesn't gallop out like that," said trainer David Hofmans. "Usually he pulls right up after the work. I feel really good about the way this horse is doing right now. The foot looked great after the work, no problems. We've finally got a little breathing room with the Breeders' Cup four weeks away." Hofmans said his colt, winner of the GI Belmont S. and GI Buick Haskell Invitational, would work again Friday, going seven-eighths with jockey Chris McCarron.

### DEPUTY COMMANDER POSSIBLE FOR

**CLASSIC** Victorious in the GI Travers and GI Super Derby in his last two appearances, three-year-old **Deputy Commander** (Deputy Minister) could make his next start against older horses in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Hollywood Park November 8. The colt worked a half-mile in :48 at Santa Anita Saturday. "It was just what we had in mind," said trainer Wally Dollase. "We're leaning toward running him in the Classic. A lot will depend on what (regular rider) Chris McCarron does. That will have something to do with it, but the horse will also tell me what we should do based on his training." McCarron is also the regular rider for Touch Gold.

### THREE NEW STALLIONS FOR HILL 'N' DALE

John G. Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farms in Lexington, Kentucky, has added three stallions to the roster for 1998. Heading the trio is five-year-old **Tejano Run** (Tejano), a graded-stakes winner at two, four and five who bankrolled \$1,166,840 during his career. Runner-up in the 1995 GI Kentucky Derby, he made his final start a winning one, taking the GIII Turfway Park Championship H. September 27. He will stand for a fee of \$5,000, live foal, and is now being syndicated. **Gold Tribute** (Mr. Prospector), a \$725,000 yearling purchase, was second by a head to Silver Charm in the GII Del Mar Futurity and third in the GI Moet Champagne S. while still a maiden in just five starts at two. Now three, he will stand for \$6,500, live foal. The third newcomer, three-year-old **Just A Cat** (Storm Cat), winner of the 1996 GII Cowdin S., will stand for \$3,500, live foal.

Countess Diana had no trouble wiring the field in the GI Spinaway S. in her most recent appearance, winning by a widening 6 1/2 lengths August 29. Making her two-turn debut here, the bay was pressured by 1-2 favorite Brilliant Pleasure through rapid early fractions, zipping three-quarters in 1:09 2/5 as they left the rest of the field nine lengths behind, but she once again proved her dominance of the division, shaking clear of that rival on the final bend and holding sway to the wire despite tiring and running greenly. "I didn't know how it was going to go, but I knew I couldn't sit back and let (Beautiful Pleasure) go onto an easy lead," said winning rider Shane Sellers. "I had to use my filly a little getting out of there and moving over to the rail. That's not usually my style. I knew we were going fast, but there wasn't anything else to do. She started to get a little leg-weary, and then she saw the starting gate (in the stretch) and ducked in toward the rail and that scared her. I had to get aggressive with her. This wasn't one of her best races, but it was her first time going two turns and she'll really improve off this." Longshot Lily O'Gold came on to be second, edging the crowd's choice on the finish line. The fillies will meet again in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Hollywood November 8.

Two-for-two at Santa Anita coming into this race, Benchmark had also shown a liking for the track at Del Mar, taking the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. last out September 7. The even-money chalk to put them back-to-back, the bay trailed the field through six furlongs in 1:10 3/5 but closed with a rush to grab the lead late and draw clear. "They slowed it up down the backside and I thought 'Oh, no,' but I figured, I'm not moving. I'm just going to ride him the way he wants to be ridden," said jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "They started picking it up after the half-mile pole, and I waited. Then, all of a sudden, he just cut. The last three-sixteenths of a mile, he really went to running." Added trainer Ron Ellis, "He's been compromised a lot of times this year by terribly slow fractions. That's why we're excited about the Breeders' Cup Classic--there's always legitimate speed in there. A mile and a quarter is a long way, but he's got the right style for it."

Coming off a four-month layoff, the third choice stalked pacesetter Dixie Flag before grabbing the lead in the stretch and holding off the late charge of Aldiza to take the four-way photo. Said winning jockey John Velazquez, "We were going against mostly sprinters, and I knew they had a bit more speed than my filly so I wanted to get her running early. She broke really well, and she was moving nice and easy. She has a tendency to hang, so at the three-eighths pole I really started to urge her along."
