SHARP CAT READY FOR RETURN Sharp Cat (Storm Cat), away since taking the nine-furlong GII Hollywood Oaks July 6, will be back in action in the mile-and-a-sixteenth GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. Sunday at Santa Anita. "We felt she needed a little freshening," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "There was nothing physically wrong with her, we just thought her campaign was tough on her. The campaign was designed to get her to the Breeders' Cup as fresh as possible, so we decided to give her a little break." The three-year-old filly, with five Grade I wins to her credit, has finished off the board only once this year, when sixth facing colts in the GI Santa Anita Derby. She was also disqualified and placed eighth after running third in the GI Kentucky Oaks. "She has been very consistent for us," said Lukas. "We'll have to see if she can get the mile and an eighth consistently, but I think she can."

BIJOU D'INDE TO ELSENHAM STUD G1SW Bijou D'Inde (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), who suffered a serious tendon injury in a spill in this year's Dubai World Cup, will make two more starts before retiring to stand at England's Elsenham Stud for 1998, according to yesterday's *Sporting Life*. The four-year-old colt, winner of the 1996 St. James Palace S. at Royal Ascot, was brought down when the Japanese mare **Hokuto Vega (Jpn)** (Nagurski) broke down in the Dubai World Cup in April, but made it back to the races in September, running eighth in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp and most recently a solid fifth, beaten only three lengths, in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot September 27. The *Sporting Life* reports that the colt will make his next appearance in the G1 Dubai Champion S. at Newmarket October 18, shipping to Hong Kong for his final start in the G2 International Cup December 14. A winner of more than \$400,000, Bijou D'Inde will stand for a fee of £6,000 (approximately \$9,500).

STABLEHANDS' STRIKE DEPLETES

LONGCHAMP PROGRAM The Grand Criterium was one of only two races run at Longchamp Sunday due to a stablehands' strike which prevented the transportation of many horses from the training centre at Chantilly to the French racecourse. The action was caused by demands for better wages and improved working conditions. Most of the races which were not run will be staged at Paris meetings later this week.

On the board in her last five starts with wins in a Belmont overnight handicap in July and the GI John A. Morris H. at Saratoga in August, Clear Mandate followed a second-place finish in the GI Ruffian H. last out September 20 with her third win of the year. The chestnut settled well off the pace as favored Feasibility Study led to the top of the lane; she launched her rally while four-wide on the final turn and just got up to take the photo. "I knew that there were a couple of horses down inside me that would probably show a lot of speed and go right to the lead, but I figured that we would be third or fourth and never more than two or three lengths off it," said winning jockey Pat Day. "When you look at the paper, I really thought we might be pretty close up front. I guess that's why you run it on the dirt and not in the paper." Added trainer Rusty Arnold, "The race wasn't run exactly like we thought it would be. We all thought she might be really sharp in the early going. But this filly has her own mind and she doesn't always do things the same. Instead of being sharp, Pat said she was dull. But instead of panicking...he let her lay back there until she was ready." The winner goes next in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Hollywood Park November 8; she was sixth in the race last year.

An import from France, Rainbow Dancer (Fr) had alternated strong performances with less successful outings in his first five U.S. starts but broke that pattern here. Winner of the GI Hollywood Turf H. in May, he was fifth in the GII Sunset H. but came back to take the GII Del Mar H. last out August 30. He made it two straight, closing from last after a mile to take the lead late and inch clear. "He's the genuine thing when he's got a pace scenario," said winning trainer Jenine Sahadi. "I thought in the beginning we were a little too far behind. We lost a step at the start, but Alex (Solis) knows this horse and knows what he's capable of." Sahadi pointed to the Breeders' Cup Turf as her charge's next start. The 7-5 favorite, GI Arlington Million victor MARLIN (Sword Dance {Ire}), was forced to check while looking for room on the first turn, made a run four-wide into the stretch and put a head in front but could not hold off the winner while drifting in and crowding both Lord Jain (Arg) and Sandpit (Brz) down the lane. He crossed the wire second but was disqualified and placed fourth, then pulled up lame and had to be vanned off. "I like to have got dropped going into the first turn...I think the injury probably happened at about that point," said his rider, Gary Stevens. "He was lugging in with me through the stretch...trying to get off the injury. I don't know how serious it is, but I shouldn't think he'll be running back in the Breeders' Cup. He was definitely lame coming off the turf course." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said after the race, "He tore his right front suspensory."

Bookmakers reacted to this comfortable success for Second Empire (Ire) by making him 3-1 favourite for next year's English 2000 Guineas and 5-1 for the 1998 Epsom Derby. Giving trainer Aidan O'Brien his first Group 1 success in France and taking his unbeaten run to three, the million-dollar yearling tracked Alboostan (GB), with G1 Prix Morny winner Charge D'Affaires (GB) in third. Entering the stretch, Alboostan tried to quicken, but Second Empire was only cruising; inside the final quarter he took total command and was never threatened. "This horse is class," said O'Brien. "I was a bit worried about the ground before the race, as he had shown so much speed on fast ground when he won the Prix des Chenes here (Sept. 14). I wouldn't want ground like this too often for him. I will now prepare him for the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket next May. He will probably have one run before that." Charge D'Affaires's trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said: "He ran well and proved he can stay a mile. He's a very consistent horse, but he was beaten by a superior horse today."

News cont.**ROYAL APPLAUSE BECOMES "ROYAL"**

STALLION Britain's champion sprinter-elect **Royal Applause (GB)** (Waajib {Ire}) has been retired and will stand at The Royal Studs at Sandringham, Norfolk, England next season. Winner in May of the G3 Duke Of York S., the four-year-old went on to capture the G3 Cork & Orrery S. at Ascot in June and the G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup in September. He was third in what would be his final start, last Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in Paris. The colt was also one of the top juveniles of 1995, winning the G1 Middle Park S., G2 Gimcrack S. and G3 Coventry S. He goes to the breeding shed with nine wins in 14 starts and earnings of \$596,714. A stud fee has yet to be announced.

Instant Friendship, third at 17-1 in the Aug. 24 Gill Saratoga Breeders' Cup H., tried an allowance race on the grass against open company last out September 5 and finished third after a troubled trip. Back on the main track facing fellow New York-breds, the dark bay raced from off the pace before working his way between horses around the far turn, swinging out four-wide entering the lane and overtaking Alabama Derby hero and GI Super Derby fourth Mr. Groush in mid-stretch. "He usually acts up before he races but today he behaved very well," winning jockey John Velazquez said. "All I wanted to do was to leave him alone. I didn't want to rush him to the lead, I just wanted him to do what he wanted to do out there. When we got to the quarter-pole, he was in full stride and he came home running hard." Trainer Leo O'Brien plans on running the winner right back in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. "He likes that distance (1 1/4 miles), and he likes Belmont Park," O'Brien said. "He's capable of running a big race." The 2-1 second choice **VICTORY SPEECH** (Deputy Minister), who was coming off a four-month layoff, prompted the early pace but tired in the stretch to finish seventh.

Irish Daisy missed by only a head in the restricted Yaddo H. at Saratoga August 7, then tried her luck against open allowance foes and ran third at Saratoga and fourth here at Belmont September 27. Let go at a generous price with a return to the state-bred ranks and the addition of blinkers, the chestnut broke sharply, held the lead through easy fractions, turned back a challenge after six furlongs in 1:13 2/5 and galloped home to win as much the best. "The last two races were somewhat of a disappointment because she should have galloped in them," said trainer Leo O'Brien. "So this time we put blinkers on her and it seemed to be the difference. She's been too lackadaisical in her last few races."

A success in the state-bred ranks, Draw Shot was 21-1 in the Gill Poker S. July 4 but came away a 1 1/4-length winner. The bay had picked up checks in his three starts since, including a strong second-place showing in the restricted Ashley T. Cole H. in his latest September 26, and improved off that finish as the chalk here. Well back through rapid opening fractions, the favorite fought through traffic on the far turn to take the lead at the head of the stretch and draw off. "He relaxed much better today than he did in his last and I think that was the key," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "I was able to keep him farther back and not make the lead until late." Trainer Angel Penna Jr. indicated the Gill Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct November 1 could be next for the winner.
