MARLIN RETIRED MGISW Marlin (Sword Dance {Ire}), injured in Sunday's GI Oak Tree Turf Championship S. at Santa Anita Park, has been retired and will go to stud for 1998. Winner of the GI Secretariat S. and the GI Crown Royal Hollywood Derby at three and the GI San Juan Capistrano and GI Arlington Million at four, the colt finished second in his final start but was disqualified and placed fourth for lugging in through the stretch. "It's his right front suspensory," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas of the injury. "It was pulled away from the ankle. There's nothing that can be done for it but rest." The Florida-bred retires with a record of nine wins from 26 starts and earnings of \$2,448,880. Stud plans have not yet been finalized.

GENTLEMEN DRILLS FOR CLASSIC Bringing a smile to trainer Richard Mandella's face, MGISW **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) zipped through seven furlongs in 1:24 3/5 with jockey Gary Stevens aboard yesterday at Hollywood Park. "I've got goose bumps right now," said Stevens after the move. "Wow! This was a different Gentlemen than the one I was riding this spring. I've never felt him in a race or a workout like he went this morning. We only went six furlongs (in 1:12 3/5) and galloped out the seven. That was awesome." Added Mandella, "I think it's safe to say the throat was fine today. We'll scope him in another three days or so just to be safe. We want to make sure it's staying on the right track. He'll probably work again on Sunday." Fifth in the GI Woodbine Mile September 20, the five-year-old came out of the race with an ulcerated throat. He will have to be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Classic for a fee of \$800,000.

TATTERSALLS OCTOBER SALE STARTS

TODAY Europe's largest yearling sale, Tattersalls October, begins this morning at 9:15 at Park Paddocks in Newmarket, England. A total of 1023 yearlings have been catalogued, including siblings of 139 Group or Listed stakes winners. Twenty-two of the top 25 British and Irish stallions are represented, including Cadeaux Genereux (GB), Caerleon, Danehill, Fairy King, In The Wings (GB), Polish Precedent and Salse, as well as top U.S. sires such as Diesis (GB), Irish River (Fr), Silver Hawk, Summer Squall and Woodman. All of the current top 10 European freshman sires will have offspring in the sale, and popular first-crop sires Barathea and Grand Lodge have six and 23 yearlings catalogued, respectively. The five-day auction continues through Saturday.

Rapid Selection stumbled at the start of the Sept. 14 GIII Noble Damsel H., losing her rider, and returned to finish second as the favorite in a Sept. 27 allowance. An outsider in this field, the grey filly stalked the early leaders, rallied three-wide turning for home and drove clear. "Everything went great for us today," said jockey Joe Bravo. "The two speed horses (Dynasty and Escena) went out and did their thing and they are two very nice horses. (Trainer) Linda (Rice) made sure that Rapid Selection would be right and she was full of run today. When I turned her loose at the top of the lane, she exploded." The 3-5 favorite ESCENA (Strawberry Road {Aus}) pressed the pace before tiring to fourth.

SKIP AWAY SHARP AT BELMONT Getting ready to defend his title in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park, champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) worked five furlongs in a sprightly :58 2/5 under jockey Jerry Bailey yesterday. The four-year-old, who bested Cigar by a head in last year's edition of the Gold Cup, galloped out six furlongs in 1:12. "All I want is for Skip Away to be a repeat winner of the Jockey Club Gold Cup," said trainer Sonny Hine. "That would be a big accomplishment." There have been seven repeat winners in the 78-year history of the race. They are: Kelso, who took five straight from 1960-64; Mad Hatter, 1920-21; Dark Secret, 1933-34; Nashua, 1955-56; the great mare Shuvee, 1970-71; Slew o'Gold, 1983-84; and Creme Fraiche, 1986-87. Skip Away is not Breeders' Cup eligible, but as for supplementing his colt to the Classic, Hine said, "I'm not ruling anything out right now, and that includes running him back next year. He's such a fun horse and, knock on wood, he's healthy and he's happy."

TROPICAL STAKES SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED

The 1997 Tropical at Calder meet which begins November 6 will offer a stakes schedule worth a track-record \$1.7 million. A total of 16 stakes, seven of them graded, boasting purses of \$100,000 and up will be run during the 51-day season. Highlighting the stakes program will be the GII \$150,000 W. L. McKnight H. December 20, and the GII \$150,000 La Prevoyante H. for fillies and mares December 27, both at a mile and a half on the turf. New on the schedule are the Hollywood Wildcat S. for two-year-old fillies and the Mecke S. for two-year-old, both to be run at a mile and a sixteenth on the grass November 22. The meet, with live racing Thursdays through Tuesdays, closes January 2, 1998.

Local News: Japan

A total of 44 foreign horses have been nominated to this year's Japan Cup, set for November 23. Heading the 11-horse list from the U.S. are Grade I winners **Awad** (Caveat), **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), **Influent** (Ascot Knight), **Rainbow Dancer (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest) and **Sandpit (Brz)** (Baynoun {Ire}). Canada has two nominees, both Grade I winners in their country: **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown) and **Cryptocloser** (Cryptoclearance). A total of 21 horses from England, France, Germany and Ireland have been nominated. They include Group 1 winners **Benny The Dip** (Silver Hawk), **Borgia (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}), **Dance Design (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Luso (GB)** (Salse), **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy), **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent) and **Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan). In addition, there are 10 nominees from Australia and New Zealand, including champion **Doriemus (NZ)** (Norman Pentaquad). The number of foreign nominees was down from 1996, when 53 horses were pre-entered for the race.
