TATTERSALLS CONTINUES TO POST GAINS A

bay filly by Robellino--Sans Blague, by The Minstrel topped vesterday's first of two Thursday sessions at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale in Newmarket, England, Selling as hip number 655, the bay yearling was consigned by Floors Stud and brought a final bid of \$212,036 from Shadwell Estate Company Ltd. At the second session, top price was paid for hip number 710, a colt from the first crop of multiple Group 1 winning stallion Bigstone (Ire) out of the Caerleon mare Aunt Hester (Ire). The yearling was purchased by agent John Ferguson from the consignment of Ireland's Round Hill Stud for Moller's Racing and brought a final bid of \$306,000. Ferguson also bought the day's top filly, hip number 718, for \$255,000. The daughter of Indian Ridge was consigned by Overbury Stud. Overall 177 yearlings sold Thursday, grossing \$9,363,090 and averaging \$52,897, advances of 11 percent and 12 percent. respectively, over the corresponding 1996 session. The day's median of \$39,100 showed a five-percent gain from last year. The sale continues through Saturday.

LOST SOLDIER RETIRED Lost Soldier (Danzig-Lady Winborne, by Secretariat) has been retired from racing and will stand the 1998 breeding season at Franks Farm in Ocala, Florida. His stud fee will be \$4,000. The seven-year-old stallion retires with 11 wins in 45 starts and earnings of \$431,621. From 26 U.S. starts, he won the 1996 GIII Louisiana Downs H. and placed in the 1994 GIII Stuyvesant H. In Dubai, Lost Soldier won the 1994 Nad Al Sheba 1600 Prestige Race and the 1995 Keeneland Mile Prestige Race. In his final race, the bay finished fourth in the July 19 Remington Park Breeders' Cup H.




