SKIP AWAY REPEATS IN GOLD CUP There was no Goliath in his path to the winner's circle this time, but Skip Away (Skip Trial), who gamely wore down Horse of the Year Cigar in the Belmont stretch last year, had to snap a three-race losing streak to earn his second straight victory in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup yesterday. Last year's three-year-old champion was second choice of the crowd, behind Californian invader Siphon (Brz) (Itaiara {Brz}) and the pair vied for the early lead in the 1 1/4-mile race. Skip Away stuck his head in front after racing a mile and exploded down the stretch to win by 61/2 lengths as Siphon, winner of the GI Santa Anita H. earlier in the year, tired to fourth. The race was marred by an accident in which Coup d'Argent (Silver Buck) suffered a fractured sesamoid and had to be put down. With the win, Skip Away became the leading Florida-bred money earner, surpassing Kentucky Derby winner Unbridled. Trainer Sonny Hine said he is still uncertain if Skip Away will run in the Breeders' Cup. "We have to digest (the win) and think about it. I doubt he can be Horse of the Year. If I thought he had a chance of being Horse of the Year, I would run him in the Breeders' Cup." Hine did say he plans to race Skip Away as a five-year-old next year. "This horse is a gift from God," the conditioner added. "He has had to overcome a lot of things, including a trainer."

TATTERSALLS CONCLUDES RECORD SALE The 1997 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale concluded Saturday morning in Newmarket, England, toppling the records established last year. At the close of business, the tally showed 911 yearlings sold for a record \$35,726,010--seven percent above last year's total. The average price of \$39,215, also a record, rose five percent from 1996. The sale's median price remained stable at \$27,200. The number of six-figure yearlings (100,000 guineas and up or \$170,000 and up) increased by 46 percent, from 13 to 19. The session topper at yesterday's fifth and final session of the sale, was hip number 966, a filly by Selkirk--Miss Blitz (GB) (Formidable). Consigned by Deerfield Farm, the yearling brought a final bid of \$83,118 from Mr. I. A. Balding. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said, "The general perception of last year's October sale was that it produced the most sustained show of strength and depth ever seen at a European yearling sale. In that context, we would have been delighted merely to consolidate on the 30 percent gains of last year. To have exceeded them is yet another tribute to the worldwide appeal of this yearling sale."

Skip Away, looking for his second Gold Cup win, was coming off of a distant second-place finish behind Formal Gold in the Sept. 20 GI Woodward H. Last year's champion three-year-old colt set the pace while being pressured by 4-5 favorite SIPHON (BRZ) (Itajara {Brz}) and swept clear of that rival turning for home. Skip Away easily drew off to a 61/2-length win as Siphon tired to fourth. "I kind of wanted to go to the lead," explained winning rider Jerry Bailey. "(Trainer) Sonny (Hine) at least wanted me to track him and make Siphon run. We broke so well and he held his position well. I had Siphon (measured) at every pole." Siphon's lackluster performance left trainer Richard Mandella a little perplexed. "He just didn't have any horse today, but he's had a great career," Mandella admitted. "This may have been his last race. He just didn't have the zeal he usually has." COUP D'ARGENT (Silver Buck) suffered a compound fracture of the sesamoid in his left foreleg during the running of the race and had to be euthanized. GOLDEN LARCH (Slew o' Gold) stumbled over the fallen horse, losing the rider, and PREPO (CHI) (Inchwood) was pulled up to avoid the spill.

A performance to grace "Champions Day" at Newmarket was the versatile 1996 Breeders Cup Turf champion Pilsudski (Ire), winner of the G1 Eclipse S. in July and runner-up in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe October 5, overcame traffic woes and survived a 10-minute stewards' inquiry. At the three-eighths pole Epsom Derby winner BENNY THE DIP (Silver Hawk) went for home along the rail, but he was soon challenged by Loup Sauvage, who had found the perfect split between horses to grab the lead. But Michael Kinane had timed his run to perfection on Pilsudski, switching him to go around Benny The Dip and then back to the rail. Inside the final furlong Lord Weinstock's five-year-old guickened brilliantly to catch Loup Sauvage and run out a comfortable winner. The stewards looked at Pilsudski's manoeuvre around Benny The Dip, who faded to sixth, but allowed the result to stand. Michael Stoute was thrilled: "This a champion and admirable horse, with a wonderful constitution to come back from his run in the Arc. Today's race did not really go according to plan, but he showed today what great acceleration he has. At the end of his three-year-old career I thought he would be a Group 3 horse last year--I was only two grades wrong! We want to go to the Japan Cup--we've got five weeks and, knowing him, I would be very hopeful that he would be on the plane."

The chestnut gelding settled off the lead of DOWTY (Irish River {Fr}), who along with entrymate Flag Down went off the even-money favorite. Grand Slam issued his challenge turning for home and the pair dueled down the lane with Grand Slam eking out a hard-fougth win. "I wasn't concerned (about Lil's Lad's big lead)," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "But when I started to make my move and we hooked him, I got a bit of a scare because he (Lil's Lad) kicked in. I haven't been on too many two-year-olds as professional as Grand Slam. He was a much more focused horse today. Before he was a little lackadaisical." Winning trainer D. Wayne Lukas indicated Grand Slam will ship to Santa Anita Monday to prepare for the November 8 Breeders' Cup Juvenile.



The winner set the pace on the inside and shook all challenges leaving the backstretch to kick clear under steady urging. "She went out there, relaxed real well," winning rider Eddie Delahoussaye said, "I waited until the head of the stretch to ask her, and she took off. She was goofing around in the stretch, so I just tapped her on the shoulder, and she picked it up a little bit. She is a nice filly. I just hope she continues improving." Winning trainer Bob Baffert said, "She's a one-dimensional filly. She just wants to be on the lead, so I told Eddie to just put her there in front and don't look back. That's why I put blinkers on her." The winner, Balisian Beauty, and sixth-place finisher EASTSIDE WESTSIDE (Eastern Echo) are headed for the Breeders' Cup. The 9-5 favorite Eastside Westside, a 12-length winner in a Sept. 4 Del Mar maiden race last time out, was bumped at the start, trailed the field early, and made a slight rally in the lane. "She was out of it from the first turn on," Bob Baffert, who also trains the winner, said. "I hadn't been cranking down on her the way I had with Vivid Angel. I was just prepping her for the Breeders' Cup."

Favorite Trick, the leading candidate for two-yearold champion, was undefeated in six starts and was coming off an authoritative win in the August 30 GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga. The prohibitive favorite was reserved in third early, rallied five wide turning for home to overtake Time Limit at midstretch and drew off to the wire. "This horse is unbelievable," an exuberant trainer Pat Byrne said after the race. "He did everything I expected him to do and more. Some people wondered if this horse could get two turns and that was a legitimate question. But I don't think there are any questions after today. I think we can win the (Kentucky) Derby. Why won't this horse go a mileand-a-quarter?" Winning rider Pat Day added, "I tried to pepper him a couple of times to get his mind on his business and he just accelerated and took off. This is a very, very good horse."
