RAINBOW DANCER OUT OF BREEDERS' CUP

TURF Rainbow Dancer (Fr) (Rainbow Quest), winner of the GI Oak Tree Turf Championship October 12, will miss this year's Breeders' Cup and may be retired after suffering a minor injury to his left front suspensory. "He threw a shoe during (the Oak Tree Turf Championship), which might have caused the problem," said trainer Jenine Sahadi. "The veterinarians examined him and recommended not to run in the Turf. He's walking fine, but with a horse like him you'd hate to take any chances." As for his future, Sahadi said, "He's six now and he'll be seven next year. I'll have to talk to the Rays (owners Carol and C.N.) about his future."

TRF PROPOSES EXCELLER MEMORIAL The Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation is hoping to establish a perpetual memorial to Exceller which would help prevent other horses from suffering his tragic fate. Exceller, the only horse to ever defeat two Triple Crown winners and a winner of over \$1 million, was sent to a slaughterhouse in Sweden last summer. "We propose that one day of racing each year be dedicated to Exceller by every track in the country operating on that day. The feature race on the card would be the TRF-Exceller Memorial Race. Equine charities that benefit the well-being of racehorses, especially horses no longer able to race due to age or infirmity, would receive a percentage of the TRF-Exceller Memorial purse and of the gate," said Monigue Koehler, TRF president and founder. Added Executive Director Diana Pikulski, "The TRF believes that Exceller's heartrending death will not have been in vain if it leads to widespread support for alternatives to the needless slaughter of so many racehorses. An Exceller Memorial Day would do more than create an avenue for racing to support organizations that provide humane retirement to the equine athletes without which there would be no racing. It is a golden opportunity for racing to reaffirm its recognition of and indebtedness to the magnificent animals that have given so much pleasure and profit."

BAHAMIAN BOUNTY TO NATIONAL STUD

Britain's National Stud yesterday announced the purchase of the Godolphin-owned three-year-old Bahamian Bounty (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). The colt has been retired and will stand for a fee of 4,500 pounds (approximately \$7,270) in 1998. He joins the stud's other new stallions for 1998--Emerati and Hector Protector-- to bring the roster to nine for next year. Bahamian Bounty won both the G1 Prix Morny Piaget at Deauville and the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket as a two-year-old and was rated joint third on the official European Free Handicap for 1996. He ran only twice at three, finishing fourth in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket. He retires with a record of three wins from six starts and earnings of \$337,304. "He was a top-class performer and there is speed throughout his pedigree," said Miles Littlewort, chief executive of the National Stud. "We think his performances, pedigree and a fee of 4,500 pounds sterling will make him very attractive to breeders in Britain and overseas."

MACHIAVELLIAN FILLY TOPS AGENCE

FRANCAISE OPENER A filly by Machiavellian out of Boudeuse (Nijinsky II) brought a final bid of \$101,531 to top yesterday's opening session of the Agence Francaise October Yearling Sale at Deauville. A halfsister to stakes-placed Galea des Bois (Fr) (Persian Bold {Ire}), she was purchased by Francois Doumen, agent for John David Martin. A total of 85 yearlings brought \$1,125,984 Monday, up 49 percent from last year's opener when 74 hips sold for \$755,563. The 1997 average of \$13,247 was up 29.7 percent from the '96 figure of \$10,210. There were 47 yearlings which were not sold. The three-day auction continues through Wednesday.

AVERAGE ON INCREASE AT FASIG-TIPTON

OCTOBER The average price during the first session of the 1997 Fasig-Tipton October Yearling Sale, held yesterday at Newton Paddocks in Lexington, Kentucky, posted a 21-percent increase, rising to \$11,472 this year as compared to \$9,465 in 1996. A total of 195 yearlings grossed \$2,237,000 during the opening day of the auction, up 35 percent from last year's first session when 175 hips sold for \$1,656,400. A filly by Unbridled out of Amo (Hold Your Peace) topped the opener, bringing a bid of \$87,000.
