SKIP AWAY TO BREEDERS' CUP

CLASSIC? It's no longer a matter of money. Trainer Sonny Hine said yesterday that **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), fresh from his victory in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, will be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Classic for a fee of \$480,000--as long as the travel arrangements can be worked out. Hine wants to send the four-year-old from New York to California on a Tex Sutton flight scheduled to leave November 5. There's plenty of room for the horse, but not for his groom. According to Hine, FAA regulations permit only a certain number of human passengers on the flight and those spots have already been filled. A Tex Sutton spokesman has said the situation can likely be worked out, but Hine will not put his horse on the plane without his groom. Hine will also need a rider for last year's Eclipse Award winner. Jockey Jerry Bailey, aboard the colt for the first time in the Gold Cup, is committed to ride Behrens in the Classic. As for the decision to put up the supplementary fee, Hine said he feels a win in the Classic will earn Skip Away "Horse of the Year" honors. "We're as good as the other horses," he said. "If we get lucky and win the race, we will have earned \$4 million (for the year) and it'll be hard for anyone to say they're better than he is. I think he's a great horse."

DEVIL'S CUP EUTHANIZED GSW **Devil's Cup** (Devil's Bag), who fractured his right front sesamoid in the GIII Fort Lauderdale H. at Gulfstream Park March 15, was put down Thursday after a seven-month effort to save his life. The four-year-old, winner of this year's GII Canadian Turf H. and third in the 1996 GI Crown Royal Hollywood Derby, had been shipped from Florida to Lexington's Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in late May for surgery to fuse the ankle; a second surgery was performed in mid-August, but the injury never healed properly and he developed laminitis in his left front foot. "He was in the pasture romping a couple of times in the last weeks, but his bones didn't fuse right," said Alan Quartucci, who oversees the Gold Spur Stable partnership which owned the colt. "It's sad. We came so far and I thought we were going to save him. None of us regret the time or money spent to keep him alive."

A. P. INDY ON THE MEND According to the *Blood-Horse On-Line*, top sire **A.P. Indy** (Seattle Slew) is recovering well after undergoing surgery for an impacted colon Tuesday at the Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital near Lexington, Kentucky. The eight-year-old came through the operation without incident; he will remain at Rood and Riddle for several days as a precaution against infection. The 1992 Horse of the Year and winner of the GI Belmont S. and GI Breeders' Cup Classic, he has sired nine stakes winners from two crops to race, including Grade I winners Tomisue's Delight, Runup The Colors and Royal Indy.

CARMINE LAKE POSSIBLE FOR BREEDERS' CUP

Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam yesterday reported that the Robert Sangster-owned three-year-old filly **Carmine Lake (Ire)** (Royal Academy) could line up for a shot at the Breeders' Cup Sprint at Hollywood Park November 8. On only her second start this year, the chestnut captured the prestigious G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp over five furlongs in Paris October 5, beating fellow Sprint candidate **Pas De Reponse** (Danzig). "She has definitely not been retired," said Chapple-Hyam. "I will look at the Breeders' Cup Sprint entries and then make up my mind. I don't know if she will go on the dirt and I have never really studied the Sprint, but she is a possible starter."

SURGERY FOR STAR STANDARD Star Standard (Risen Star), who fractured his left front cannon bone, sesamoid and pastern in the eighth race at Keeneland Wednesday, underwent surgery at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington yesterday. During the four-hour procedure, a total of 22 screws, 36 inches of orthopedic wire and a plate were used to repair the leg. The five-year-old, who had not been out since taking the GI Pimlico Special May 11, 1996, was in critical condition at Rood and Riddle following the operation. The Kentucky-bred bay has won seven races and more than \$1.1 million.
