fever may keep MGISW Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois) out of this year's Breeders' Cup Classic. The fiveyear-old spiked a temperature Thursday morning. "It actually started out a few days before that, because he didn't clean up his feed as quick as he usually does," said trainer Richard Mandella. "Then (Thursday) morning he was hit with a temperature of 102. It went down a bit (Thursday night), but it's still there. It was 101.2 (Friday) morning. We've taken a blood test on him and it's off kilter a little." The Argentine would have to be supplemented to the Classic for \$800,000, with onethird due Monday, but Mandella said, "Right now, things aren't looking good. We're going to watch it a few more days and then make our final decision. It would take quite an impression to run right now, but I'm not going to say 'we're out' today."

- CLASSIC CONTENDERS BREEZE Three of the top contenders for the \$4 million Classic worked at Hollywood Friday morning. Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), winner of the GI Woodward S. last out September 20, went seven furlongs in 1:25 2/5. "It looked good to me," said trainer Bill Perry. "I've just got to keep him in one piece and he'll be ready." Three-yearold Touch Gold (Deputy Minister) tuned up with a mile in 1:39 with jockey Chris McCarron in the irons. "He did it the right way, doing most of his running down the lane," said McCarron. Added trainer David Hofmans, "The foot looks great. He has a new patch on the foot. We put it on right after his last work, and it should hold right through the Breeders' Cup." Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister) zipped seven-eighths in 1:24 2/5 with jockey Corey Nakatani aboard. Nakatani, the colt's regular rider earlier this year, lost the mount to Chris McCarron due to a suspension prior to his victories in the Travers and Super Derby, but will back in the saddle for the Classic.


