BREEDERS' • CUP BULLETIN

● **SPRINT HOPEFULS BREEZE** Four candidates for the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Sprint showed their speed Saturday morning. Working at Hollywood Park, MGSW Northern Afleet (Afleet) breezed five furlongs in 1:00 1/5, while **Men's Exclusive** (Exclusive Ribot), three-for-four on the year, went the same distance in :59 3/5; **Swiss Yodeler** (Eastern Echo) zipped six furlongs in a bullet 1:11 2/5. At Santa Anita, **Larry The Legend** (Local Talent), still looking for his first win since taking the mile-and-an-eighth GI Santa Anita Derby April 8, 1995, cruised through five-eighths in a bullet :58 3/5. The five-year-old was third in the GIII Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. last out October 11. The Sprint is the one race sure to overfill this year; the top eight Breeders' Cup point earners will automatically get into the race, with the remaining six slots filled by the Breeders' Cup Ltd. Racing Directors/Secretaries Panel. Of the four horses working yesterday, only Northern Afleet, with 24 points, is assured of a place in the gate.

● **BC BANTER...** Three-year-old **Kelly Kip** (Kipper Kelly), winner of the GII Forest Hills H. over older horses last out October 19, will be supplemented to the Sprint; jockey Jean-Luc Samyn rides... Samyn has also picked up the mount aboard **Ops Smile** (Caveat) for the Turf... jockey Chris McCarron has committed to ride **Exotic Wood** (Rahy) in the Sprint and European import **Rajpoute** (Fr) (Double Bed {Fr}) in the Turf... Distaff hopeful **Radu Cool** (Carnivalay) worked seven furlongs in an impressive 1:23 3/5 at Santa Anita Saturday, fastest work of the day at the distance.

Saratoga Springs displayed great courage to land the final Group 1 race of the English season and take his fourth win from seven lifetime starts. MOUNTAIN SONG (GB) (Tyrol {Ire}) set a quick early pace and still led as the field rounded the home turn, but his pursuers were lining up to challenge. CRAIGSTEEL (GB) (Suave Dancer) quickened at the three-eighth pole to grab the lead but was himself overtaken at the quarter pole by a rallying Saratoga Springs; Mudeer (GB) looked to be going ominously well in the final furlong, but could not get by him. Mutamam (GB), who didn't get a clear run, finished fast to take third place. The winner did have to survive a stewards' enquiry, and a jubilant winning owner Michael Tabor said, "Mick (Kinane) was at his very best and I'm obviously delighted. With this one, Second Empire (Ire) and King Of Kings (Ire) we have something to dream about over the winter." Winning trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "It's frightening how good our colts could be. We don't work them together at home, they just enjoy themselves on the gallops. Mick Kinane said (Saratoga Springs) gets to the front and then thinks he has done enough--he is very laid back. He just sleeps and eats at home...he is a lovely horse and trains himself. He would get any trip but is getting quicker and quicker with every race. This is definitely a Classic horse and he could run in the (2000) Guineas and the Derby."

Ninth Inning had no trouble handling maiden and allowance foes in her first two starts and struck out the side in her graded-stakes debut as well. Off as the 6-5 favorite, the bay stumbled at the start but recovered to sit just off the pace, swept to the lead on the final turn and sent her rivals to the showers with an impressive stretch run. "She's just so gifted," said trainer Jimmy Jerkens, son of Hall of Famer Allen Jerkens. "She bobbed a little at the start, but she got her act together quickly. Whenever they're able to do that, it's the sign of a nice athlete." As for what's next, Jerkens, who saddled his first stakes winner here, said, "She's run three times now pretty close together, so we'll probably take it easy with her now. I haven't really got anything planned for her...I'm just happy to get by this one."
