KEENELAND WRAP-UP On-track handle and attendance showed slight gains at the 1997 Keeneland Fall Meeting which ended Saturday. Average daily attendance was 12,811, up 1.9 percent from last year's average of 12,575. A total of \$20,146,595 was wagered on-track during the 16-day meeting, up 2.5 percent from the 1996 total of \$19,653,604; the daily average handle was \$1,259,162. But handle from all sources dropped 13.1 percent, from \$88,120,207 in 1996 to \$76,579,262 this year; the daily average was \$4,786,204, down from \$5,507,513 a year ago. Jockey Shane Sellers led the rider standings with 30 wins. D. Wayne Lukas topped the trainers with nine wins and W.T. Young's Overbrook Farm was the leading owner with seven victories.

TATTERSALLS AUTUMN SALE RESULTS Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale concluded yesterday in Newmarket, England. The day's high price was \$141,183, bid by agent Charlie Gordon-Watson for the three-year-old staying handicapper **Heart of Gold (Ire)** (Broken Hearted--Originality, by Godswalk), a full brother to G2 Yorkshire Cup winner **Key to My Heart (Ire)**. Purchased for racing in Saudi Arabia, Heart of Gold won three times this season. Overall, 252 horses sold on Wednesday for an aggregate of \$5,956,615 and averaged \$23,637. The gross was up 24 percent from the corresponding session last year, while the average gained 10 percent. The median price of \$15,687 was up 29 percent.

FASIG-TIPTON WINTER SALE RESCHEDULED

Fasig-Tipton has rescheduled its Winter Mixed Sale in Lexington, Kentucky from early January to Sunday, February 8. The sale will precede that evening's Stallion Access Sale of Seasons and Shares. "We found that creating a separate time-frame and identity for our Fall yearling sale in October rather than September really contributed to that sale's growth," said Fasig-Tipton president Walt Robertson. "This new date for our Winter Mixed Sale should prove more convenient for consignors and help us expand this sale." Entries for the Winter Mixed Sale will close on December 15.

PEDIGREE SHORTS

Juvenile **Halo River** (c, 2, **Irish River** {Fr}--**All Hal-lows by Halo**) confirmed the promise of a winning debut with a four-length victory in last Sunday's Gold Digger S. at Hawthorne. The Irish River/Halo combination has previously produced Group 1 winning European miler Exit to Nowhere, and it certainly gives an interesting pedigree pattern. Halo's broodmare sire, Cosmic Bomb, is a half-brother to the dam of Prince John, and Prince John appears as the maternal grand-sire of Riverman (sire of Irish River). The Prince John/Halo combination has worked via a variety of sources and is always worth a try. A second point unique to this cross is that Halo is a grandson of Turn-to, and Irish River's third dam is half-sister to Turn-to, thus giving Halo River a 5 x 5 cross of Turn-to's dam, Source Sucree.
