GENTLEMEN TOPS JAPAN CUP INVITEES

MGISW **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois), forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Hollywood Park November 8 due to a fever, heads a list of four North American horses invited to this year's Japan Cup in Tokyo November 23. A winner of three Grade I races on the dirt this year, the five-year-old was most recently fifth in the GIC Woodbine Mile on the turf September 20. Also on the list are two Breeders' Cup Turf hopefuls--last year's Canadian champion turf horse **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown), winner of the GI Canadian International last out; and **Val's Prince** (Eternal Prince), who captured the GI Turf Classic in his latest. The four-year-old filly **Maxzene** (Cozzene), a two-time Grade II winner this year and runner-up in the GI Beverly D. and GI Flower Bowl Invitational in her last two starts, rounds out the quartet. The four European candidates are the 1996 Breeders' Cup Turf hero **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent), winner in this year's G1 Coral-Eclipse S., G1 Irish Champion S. and G1 Dubai Champion S.; G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. victor **Swain (Ire)** (Nashwan); G1 Irish St. Leger winner **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy); and G1 German Derby heroine **Borgia (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}), who will make her next start in the Breeders' Cup Turf. The two runners invited from Oceania are **Doriemus (NZ)** (Norman Pentaquod, by Riverman), last year's champion older horse Down Under; and **Vialli (Ire)** (Niniski), a Group winner in both Germany and New Zealand.

TAMAYAZ TO NORTHVIEW Northview Stallion Station, with Lillingston Bloodstock acting as agent, has purchased **Tamayaz** (Gone West--Minstrelsy, by The Minstrel). "Tamayaz is our second purchase of a Gone West son," said Northview Stallion President Richard Golden. "We could not be happier with our first purchase, West by West, and Tamayaz has all the same assets. He is extremely correct, a very good race horse on both turf and dirt, with an excellent pedigree." The five-year-old stallion, winner of the 1996 G3 Rose of Lancaster S., was a \$475,000 yearling at the 1993 Keeneland July sale. He arrived at Northview on October 29 and will stand for a stud fee of \$5,000 live foal.

TATTERSALLS SALE CONCLUDES WITH

NUMBERS UP Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale concluded with a short session Thursday morning in Newmarket, England. The highest price of the session was paid for stakes winning three-year-old sprinter **Proud Native (Ire)** (Imp Society--Karamana, by Habitat). He joined trainer David Nicholls's yard for a bid of \$69,720. Overall totals for the four-day sale showed 794 horses sold for a total of \$17,906,540 and an average of \$22,550. The aggregate was up 12 percent from last year's sale, while the average gained 11 percent. The median remained steady at \$12,201. The gross and average set records for the second consecutive year. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony commented at the close of the proceedings, "This is a unique sale and every year it attracts a unique cast of overseas buyers, as well as great support from the National Hunt fraternity. Every continent in the world was represented by buyers this week which is a tribute to the international reputation of British and Irish racing."

GOFFS SALES RESULTS At yesterday's first session of the Goffs Horses in Training and Autumn Bonus Yearling Sale in Kildare, Ireland, top price was paid for hip number 16, **Old Ivory (GB)** (Old Vic--Ivory Dawn, by Sir Ivor). The three-year-old filly was purchased for \$56,608 by B.B.A. (Ireland) Ltd. During the opening session, 49 horses sold for a total of \$378,661 and an average of \$7,728. The sale concludes today.
