● **FORMAL GOLD INJURED; OUT OF CLASSIC**

Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) will miss the November 8 GI Breeders' Cup Classic after suffering a condylar fracture of his right hind leg Thursday morning at Hollywood Park. The injury was discovered after he returned from a morning gallop. "(Exercise rider) David Nunn called me here, as he does every day, about 7:00 Thursday morning and he told me that Formal Gold ate well and was doing great and he was going out to train him," said trainer Bill Perry from his barn at Aqueduct yesterday. "About 11:30 a.m. our time, David called back. The vet hadn't even seen Formal Gold yet, but David told me that the horse wasn't doing good. He said it looked like it was an ankle, and that's what it was." Said Nunn, "We jogged a mile and three-eighths. He came off the track great, jogged home, and I said, 'they'll never beat this horse.' We took him outside and gave him a bath. As soon as we walked him off from the bath, he couldn't walk." Perry said Dr. Wayne McIlwraith was scheduled to perform surgery today or tomorrow, and that the prognosis was excellent for the four-year-old to race again. "I feel bad about this because Formal Gold had shown his talent all year long and this was a chance for him to show it to the world," said Perry. "I really felt he was going to run a big race in the Breeders' Cup, and by winning it, would be Horse of the Year. I guess right now I feel pretty numb." Formal Gold won four of eight starts this year, including the GI Woodward S., GI Donn H., GI Philip H. Iselin H. and GI Brooklyn H., and earned \$978,500 in 1997.

● **TOUCH GOLD, DEPUTY COMMANDER TUNE UP**

Belmont Stakes winner Touch Gold (Deputy Minister) breezed one mile yesterday morning at Hollywood Park in 1:38 1/5, while two-time GI winner Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister) went the distance a tick faster in 1:38. Both are preparing for the Breeders' Cup Classic. Chris McCarron was aboard Touch Gold, and saw him through fractions of :24 4/5, :48 4/5, and three-quarters in 1:12 4/5. "He was very aggressive," said trainer David Hofmans, "maybe too aggressive for Chris. When they crossed the wire, I said, 'Holy smoke!' He didn't want to pull up. I couldn't be more happy. This sets him up for the big race." Deputy Commander's connections were equally pleased with their colt's move. "The work served its purpose," said Corey Nakatani, aboard for the drill. "We started him off slow and finished up fast. I'll be smiling if he does that in the Breeders' Cup."

● **SHOEMAKER TO RETIRE FROM TRAINING**

Bill Shoemaker announced yesterday that he will retire from training at the conclusion of the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita Park this Monday. Shoemaker, 66, rode more winners--8,833--than any jockey in history before retiring to train February 3, 1990. "I just decided that I couldn't devote as much time to the business as I would like," said Shoemaker. After speaking with his owners, Shoemaker said he planned to turn most of the 25 horses in his care over to assistant Paddy Gallagher. Santa Anita will salute Shoemaker with a ceremony in the winner's circle after tomorrow's third race. "I'd certainly like to thank all the owners for their wonderful support," said Shoemaker, who sent out 90 winners from 713 runners in his seven-and-a-half-year career as a trainer. His starters earned \$3,699,439. "I plan to be around, but I'll be out here from now on as a fan."

● **THREE MORE STALLIONS TO LEAVE VINERY**

Stuka (Jade Hunter), Twilight Agenda (Devil's Bag) and Rockamundo (Key to the Mint) will leave Vinery in Midway, Ky. and stand at stud elsewhere in 1998, bringing to six the number of Vinery stallions that will have moved since the end of the 1997 breeding season, it was announced yesterday by the farm's owners, Elaine and Ben Walden Jr. Stuka will be relocated to Dr. David Menard's Magnolia Run Farm in Summerfield, Florida, where he will remain the property of a syndicate headed by Vinery and Allen Paulson; Twilight Agenda has been sold to James E. Helzer and will stand at JEH Stallion Station in Pilot Point, Texas; and Rockamundo, owned by Gary and Mary West, will be offered for private sale. "After a dozen years of lush growth, Elaine and I look ahead to a heightened level of quality in the Vinery organization as we streamline our operation," said Ben Walden Jr. This past summer, Walden announced plans to trim the stallion roster, and shortly thereafter Black Tie Affair (Ire) was sold to Japan, and Prenup and Dixie Brass were moved to Virginia and N.Y., respectively.

FASIG, LONE STAR EXPAND SALES

SCHEDULE Fasig-Tipton Company, Inc. and Lone Star Park at Grand Prairie officials announced yesterday that they had reached an agreement for Fasig-Tipton to conduct 1998 two-year-olds-in-training and summer yearling sales at Lone Star Park, located between Dallas and Fort Worth. The agreement marks an expansion of the relationship between the two organizations, which jointly held a two-year-olds-in-training sale this past March. The second annual two-year-olds-in-training sale will be held March 17, 1998. Entries will for the sale will close December 5, 1997. The yearling sale, a new addition to Fasig-Tipton's sales schedule at Lone Star Park, will be held August 31 and September 1, 1998.

GOFFS SALE CONCLUDES The Goffs Horses in Training and Autumn Bonus Yearling sale in Kildare, Ireland concluded yesterday. The highest price of the session was paid for hip no. 147, a yearling colt by Scenic (Ire)--Miss Bagatelle (GB), who was sold to Patrick J. Flynn for \$35,953. A total of 149 horses sold yesterday for a gross of \$601,191 and an average of \$4,034. Over the two-day sale, 198 horses sold for a total of \$979,852, an average of \$4,948, down 22% from last year's sale.
