#### ●BYRNE DUO BURN UP THE TRACK When

trainer Pat Byrne arrived at Hollywood with his trio of Breeders' Cup contenders--undefeated Favorite Trick (Phone Trick) for the Juvenile, Countess Diana (Deerhound) for the Juvenile Fillies and Richter Scale (\*Habitony) for the Sprint, he said they "won't do much in the way of works--no fancy bullet works." But after two of his charges lit up the track with sizzling fivefurlong moves Saturday, trainer Bob Baffert labeled the English-born conditioner "Bullet Byrne." Favorite Trick, sure to be favored in the Juvenile, went the distance in :58 4/5, while stablemate Richter Scale showed his speed with a bullet :57 1/5. "It was easy, basically," said Byrne of Favorite Trick's breeze. "He worked on his own, really easy. I wasn't looking for a quick work, but this track does play quick to quick horses. Based on what I see--the way this horse is doing and acting--he's ready to peak on November 8." As for his Sprint hopeful, Byrne said, "He has trained brilliantly. He's ready."

**DESERT KING TO SKIP TURF** Dual Classic winner **Desert King (Ire)** (Danehill), one of two Irish entries, will miss the Turf after coming down with a fever. Aidan O'Brien, trainer of this year's Irish 2000 Guineas and Budweiser Irish Derby winner, said Saturday: "He has developed a temperature and on vet's advice we have decided not to travel."

#### **•JEWEL PRINCESS READIES FOR TITLE**

FIGHT Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine and champion older mare Jewel Princess (Key to the Mint) prepped for her title defense yesterday, breezing five furlongs in 1:00 at Hollywood. "She finished good and strong," said trainer Wally Dollase. "She's not even blowing. She only runs during the last part of the race anyway, so that's all she needs. She's fit." The five-year-old has been on the board in all six starts this year but is winless since taking the GI Santa Margarita Invitational H. March 9: she was third in the Beldame last out.

#### **•SILVER MAIDEN OUT OF JUVENILE**

FILLIES Undefeated Silver Maiden (Silver Buck), twice a winner over colts and seven lengths the best in the GI Frizette last out, will miss the Juvenile Fillies after contracting a virus. Anxious moments for the connections of Sprint hopeful Royal Applause (GB) (Waaiib {Ire}) yesterday when the four-year-old colt, winner of the G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup and third in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye last out October 5, flipped while schooling in the gate. Luckily, he was not seriously injured. "He went up, down and turned himself around," said the International Racing Bureau's Alastair Donald, who witnessed the incident. "It was a bit unpleasant, but it looked worse than it was. The horse is okay. He's got one superficial graze on his hind leg." The bay has won four of six starts this year...Classic candidate Savinio (The Minstrel) breezed seven furlongs in 1:25 3/5 Saturday with jockey Chris Antley in the saddle; Antley will also be aboard for the Breeders' Cup...three-year-old Behrens (Pleasant Colony), also prepping for the \$4 million event, went an easy six furlongs in 1:15 3/5 at Saratoga yesterday; he ships to California Wednesday. "You can't believe how great it's been up here (in Saratoga) and how supportive the people are of Behrens," said trainer Jim Bond. "Everywhere you look, people are wearing 'Behrens' caps. I bet every television set within 50 miles of here will be tuned to the Breeders' Cup Classic, and I think we're going to come back with the big prize."... Making his American bow after winning a Listed stakes at La Teste, France in his European finale September 21, Prussian Blue adapted quickly to his new surroundings. The second choice in this seven-horse field, the bay stalked TOP GLORY (FR) (Le Glorieux {GB}) for a mile and a quarter, grabbed a clear lead at the head of the lane and had to fight hard to turn back the late bid of Embraceable You (Fr). "He just came two weeks ago, and I haven't had enough time to mess him up," said winning trainer Jean-Pierre Dupuis, "We just put new shoes on him and fed him, and took him on some long gallops every two days. He's a lovely horse and he has good form." Dupuis said the long-term goal would be the GI San Juan Capistrano April 19, but plans for the winner's next start have not yet been determined. The pacesetter gave jockey David Flores a wild ride. Rank through the early fractions, Top Glory had his saddle slip before they reached the first turn and went very wide around the clubhouse turn, causing Flores to lose his right iron. The rider then kicked his other foot out of the iron while wide down the backstretch, but regained his stirrups on the final bend; the pair battled back bravely when joined by the winner only to weaken in the stretch and finish last, "I pulled my saddle back in place and then I realized I should finish the race," said Flores. "At least I got back in the saddle, but it really was over once my saddle slipped." The 4-5 favorite LORD JAIN (ARG) (Lord Hailey) ran evenly to be fifth. "Gary (Stevens) said the horse just didn't kick in," said trainer Bob Baffert. "The turf course may have been a little firm, may have been stinging him a little."



Trail City, winner of last year's GII American Derby on the grass, was out of action for eight months before making his first start this season and didn't find the winner's circle until taking a Belmont allowance test in his third outing off the layoff September 5. Second, beaten just a half-length, in the GIII Keeneland Breeders' Cup Mile last out October 5, the dark bay was odds-on to pick up his first stakes score at four and did so impressively, rallying from sixth to take it by a widening five lengths. Explaining the long absence, assistant trainer Ralph Nicks said, "You give him a vacation, it just takes a while to get him going. Plus, when you get him racing, it takes two of three races to get him back into his form. It looks like he's coming back to his old self." The colt, owned by his trainer, Bill Mott, will make his next start in the GIII River Cities H. at Churchill Downs November 16.

Keene Dancer, an easy winner over stakes foes at Retama Park in August and Louisiana Downs in September, stepped up in class to try graded competition for the first time and made it three in a row. The crowd's choice sat just off the pace to the far turn, swept to the lead with a four-wide move at the top of the lane and pulled away under jockey Pat Day. "We'll sit down and talk to the Frederick family (owners of Tri County Farm) now and discuss what his next race will be," said trainer David Carroll, who was winning his first stakes at Churchill Downs. "He's nominated to the Brown & Williamson Kentucky Jockey Club (GIII, 1 1/16 miles, November 29) and we'd love to get him a race going around two turns by the end of the year. He's shown an affinity for this track, so we'll definitely discuss it."


