• **TWICE THE VICE OUT OF DISTAFF** Twice the Vice (Vice Regent), one of the favorites for Saturday's Distaff, has been retired from racing after suffering a stress fracture in her left cannon bone. "The injury must have happened in her last race," trainer Ron Ellis said. "I had her on the track (Saturday) and her exercise rider said that she was hitting the ground perfect. There was this bump on her ankle (Saturday afternoon) that she didn't have before, so I got a little nervous. We took some precautionary x-rays and our worries were confirmed." Twice the Vice, a winner of 12 of 23 starts and \$1,447,063, was beaten two lengths by Sharp Cat in what would be her final start, the Oct. 19 Gil Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. Among her wins; this year's GI Vanity H. and the 1996 editions of the GI Apple Blossom H., GI Santa Margarita H. and GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. As a three-year-old she won the GI Del Mar Oaks Invitational. The six-year-old mare will be bred to Gone West in 1998.

• **SKIP AWAY WORKS FOR CLASSIC** GI Jockey Club Gold Cup winner Skip Away (Skip Trial) breezed five furlongs yesterday morning in 1:01 over a sloppy Belmont main track with Classic jockey Mike Smith in the irons. With the dogs up twenty-five feet from the rail, Skip Away went in fractions of :23 4/5, :36, :48 1/5 and galloped out in 1:15. "It was awful fast considering that they had double dogs around the track," commented trainer Sonny Hine. "I'm very pleased with the way he worked today, but if it was any faster I would have been upset." Hine confirmed that last year's Champion Three-Year-Old will ship out of Belmont Park this Wednesday at 5:30 a.m.

• **SINGSPIEL SPARKLES IN FINAL TURF WORK** Turf favorite Singspiel (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) worked seven furlongs over the Hollywood turf course in 1:26 3/5 yesterday. The five-year-old clicked off fractions of :26 3/5 and :51 4/5 and ran his final quarter-mile in :22 2/5. Singspiel's 7 a.m. work happened three hours before the traditional opening of the Hollywood turf. "Turf works are usually at 10 a.m.," explained Racing Secretary Martin Panza. "(Trainer) Michael Stoute came to me and asked if he could go early because it's been warm here the last couple of days. For a horse of his stature, we can make an exception every once in a while, but it's not normal policy." Temperatures in the area Sunday reach the 90s. Breeders' Cup Bulletin cont. p. 2

Ryafan, fresh off of a 1 1/2-length win in the Oct. 4 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. in her American debut and a Grade 1 winner in France last year, was the second choice of the Santa Anita bettors here. Always near the front, the bay filly took the lead at the top of the stretch and kicked clear to the wire for her fourth straight win. DANCE DESIGN (IRE) (Sadler's Wells) came in at midstretch and bumped favored Memories of Silver who was attempting to squeeze through along the rail. The stewards allowed the original order of finish to stand after determining Memories of Silver was partially culpable for the incident. "There was no question I had room," Memories of Silver's jockey Jerry Bailey said after the race. "I was in there. There was daylight between me and the rail. There was daylight between me and Dance Design. That proves right there that there was room. I thought it was amazing that my filly got back up to be third. I think the incident cost me the race." Winning trainer John Gosden didn't sweat the stewards' inquiry. "I have waited longer in England, because they can never wrestle up all the stewards. Some of them get lost in the bar." Gosden said Ryafan will run next in the November 30 GI Matriarch at Hollywood Park.

After checking at the top of the stretch, the grey colt swung to the outside to get by Voyagers Quest in deep stretch. "It got a little crowded in the stretch," admitted winning jockey Alex Solis. "I just had to be patient and wait for a good opening. We got out in the clear and he flew home." Trainer Diane Perkins indicated the Nov. 30 Hollywood Derby would be next for her charge.

Sweetzie, winless in six previous starts this year, was coming off of a third-place outing in an Oct. 24 Aqueduct turf allowance. Unexpectedly back on the main track here, the winner was reserved early, launched her rally four-wide entering the stretch, and caught front-running Sweet Sondra inside the final furlong for her first stakes win. "I was expecting to be on the lead but it didn't turn out that way," winning jockey Jorge Chavez said. "She (Sweetzie) was going in stride, and I just wanted to sit back and wait for the stretch. I took her to the outside and when she switched leads she just went right by." The weather was much to the liking of winning trainer Rita Nash. "The European horses were what I was afraid of because I was afraid of a soft turf course, and they tend to like that," Nash said. "When I heard the weather forecast for today, I just kept hoping that it would rain and they would take this race off the turf, and things worked out." TULIPA (Alleged), who shipped in from France for this event, prompted the early pace but tired in the lane in her first start on dirt.
