## •SINGSPIEL BREAKS DOWN;

**OUT OF TURF** Singspiel (Ire) (In The Wings {GB}), the shortest-priced morning-line favorite for any of the Breeders' Cup races drawn Wednesday, has been scratched from the Turf after

suffering a condylar fracture of the right front cannon bone during a workout yesterday morning. The fiveyear-old was breezing a half-mile on the Hollywood turf course when his exercise rider, Kevin Bradshaw, felt him bobble and pulled him up 20 yards from the wire. Unable to see the horse ambulance due to heavy fog, Bradshaw dismounted and led Singspiel back to the guarantine barn. Trainer Michael Stoute said the injury was not deemed life-threatening, and was "totally unrelated" to the pulse detected in his charge's left front foot Tuesday. "He's always been very sound," said Stoute. "You can't put that sort of mileage on a horse if he isn't." Anthony Stroud, Sheikh Mohammed's racing manager, added, "These things happen and I can't attribute any of it to the course condition. This was to be his last race and obviously it's better that it happened today rather than on Saturday. I just spoke to Sheikh Mohammed and told him. He's very concerned for the horse and everybody involved, but there is no better man than the boss when things go wrong." Singspiel will likely undergo surgery today.

•CLASSIC...Trainer Walter Greenman announced a jockey change for his Classic candidate Savinio (The Minstrel), replacing Chris Antley with Alex Solis, who had ridden the seven-year-old in his last two starts.

**•BC WORKTAB...**Sprint hopeful Hesabull (Dispersal) breezed two furlongs...Rajpoute (Fr) (Double Bed {Fr}), starting in the Turf, worked four furlongs over the grass in :49 2/5...Spinning World (Nureyev) blew out 2½ furlongs in preparation for the Mile. Jockey Cash Asmussen was aboard for the move and afterwards commented, "He's certainly come on since his three-year-old year, but nobody's 'home and hosed' before they run the race."

### WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES by Alan Porter

#### PEDIGREE SHORTS...

Although in general we are not in favor of inbreeding to stallions through sons, there are some exceptions. One of these is the duplication of Northern Dancer through Lyphard and Nijinsky II, which at the time of a study by Roger Lyons some 18 months ago had accounted for 22 percent of all stakes winners with Northern Dancer duplications. One horse who may be benefiting from the combination is Jade Hunter, who is out of a mare by a son of Lyphard. His Coronation Futurity (GIC) winner Classic Result (c, 2, Jade Hunter--Summer Run, by Sharpen Up {GB}) is the third of his 14 stakes winners to carry Nijinsky II in the dam, one of the other two being Grade I winner Stuka.

Saturday's GIII Laurel Futurity winner Fight For M'Lady (c, 2, Fit to Fight--Flowers For M'Lady, by Stage Door Johnny) has opposite sex crosses of Nasrullah, Count Fleet and Princequillo. However, we were really intrigued by another clever cross in the pedigree. Fit to Fight's fourth dam, Black Carse, is by Black Toney out of Friar's Carse. In the dam's side of his pedigree, Fight For M'Lady has Relic, who is by War Relic (son of Friar's Carse) out of Bridal Colors (by Black Toney).

Recently, we wrote that it wouldn't be long before Japanese breeding would be producing horses capable of winning stakes in Europe and the U.S. We make no claim to a prophetic gift, but all the same we were delighted to see the Prix Le Fabuleux at Saint-Cloud captured by the Japanese-bred Limnos (Jpn) (c, 3, Hector Protector--Lingerie {GB}, by Shirley Heights {GB}). A key reason behind our thinking was that Japanese breeders now have the material to create "clever" matings, and matings certainly don't come much "cleverer" than the one which resulted in Limnos. To start with, Never Bend appears 4x4 through Riverman and Mill Reef. This pair are related since Riverman's broodmare sire Prince John and Mill Reef's dam Milan Mill are both by Princequillo out of Count Fleet mares. For good measure, Limnos' third dam, Trick Chick, is also by Prince John, so Prince John/Milan Mill appear 5x4x4. Secondly, Hector Protector's sire, Woodman, is out of a mare inbred to Busanda and her three-parts-sister Striking, both daughters of War Admiral out of daughters of La Troienne. In his dam, Limnos has Mr. Busher, a son of War Admiral out of a daughter of La Troienne. Finally, Limnos has Northern Dancer 5x3, this being unusual in both instances involving a daughter.
