• BREEDERS' CUP XIV: CLASSIC PERFORMANCES, CLASSIC QUESTION

The 1997 Horse of the Year put up a powerful performance at Hollywood Park yesterday

afternoon, leaving his rivals in the dust and no doubt as to his dominance in the 14th running of the Breeders' Cup Championship. But his identity is still a mystery. Now the debate begins. Is undefeated **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick), a perfect eight-for-eight after a 5 1/2-length romp in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, horse enough to follow Secretariat as only the second two-year-old to be named Horse of the Year? Or should that honor go to the four-year-old **Skip Away** (Skip Trial), last year's Eclipse Award champ as top three-year-old and a runaway six-length winner of the Breeders' Cup Classic? Trainer Pat Byrne pointed to his Favorite Trick as he crossed the finish line and said, "There's the Horse of the Year!" He added after the race, "Why not? You saw how easy this horse runs. Pricks his ears and plays with the competition. This horse really amazes me." Countered Skip Away's conditioner, Sonny Hine, "Skip Away never missed a beat. We ran a couple of times when we probably shouldn't have. I don't want to take away from the two-year-old, but he's a two-year-old. Older horses carry weight and give weight all year. Skip Away is a great horse. I didn't run him (in the Breeders' Cup) for the money, I wanted to show the world how great he is." Six Breeders' Cup records were set or equaled, including Favorite Trick's 1 1/16 miles in 1:41 2/5, and Skip Away's mile-and-a-quarter in 1:59. Also registering new marks were **Countess Diana** (Deerhound), 1:42 in the Juvenile Fillies; **Elmhurst** (Wild Again), 1:08 in the Sprint; and **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown), 2:23 4/5 in the Turf. **Spinning World** (Nureyev) equaled the Mile record, going in 1:32 2/5. Divisional honors were decided in at least four categories: two-year-old colt, two-year-old filly, older horse and three-year-old filly, with **Ajina** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) nailing down that award with a win in the Distaff. But the vote for the very best of the class of 1997 will come down to the wire.

*Whiskey Wisdom, whose sire Wild Again survived a foul claim to take the inaugural Classic at Hollywood in '84, finished third but was DQ'ed and placed fourth.

Skip Away missed his chance for Horse of the Year honors last year. After beating the great Cigar in the Jockey Club Gold Cup, the grey skipped the Breeders' Cup when trainer Sonny Hine became ill. The prevailing opinion was that the thought of putting up \$480,000 to run in the Classic had precipitated the hospital stay, but Hine quelled those rumors by supplementing his colt this year and coming away with the winner's share of the pot. Much the best in taking the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup for the second straight year October 18, the grey was bet down to 9-5 but put on a 1-5 show, dragging jockey Mike Smith to the lead after six furlongs in 1:09 3/5 and cruising away from his rivals in an awesome display. His time of 1:59 was two-fifths faster than Cigar's Classic record, set at Belmont Park in 1995. "I left the gate running," said Smith, winning his second Breeders' Cup race of the day and his eighth overall. "Fifty yards out, he took hold of me. He dominated today. I don't know if there's a horse in the world who could have beaten him today. If that wasn't a Horse of the Year performance, I don't know what is." Added Hine, "He's a remarkable horse. He overcame the time, the weather and my training." Second choice TOUCH GOLD (Deputy Minister) was finished after six furlongs and trailed in ninth. "He broke a little slow, got bounced around...and then got completely shut off in the turn," said trainer David Hofmans. "He was trying to get out a little bit, maybe the track was stinging his foot."

Starring in the Turf after the late scratch of the much-heralded Singspiel (Ire), 12-furlong specialist Chief Bearhart was coming off back-to-back wins in the GII C Sky Classic H. and GI Canadian International. First or second in five of six at this distance, the four-year-old was looking to better an 11th-place showing in last year's Turf. Settled in eighth for a mile, he moved steadily to join the leaders in midstretch and dug down to outgame three-year-old filly Borgia (Ger) for the record-setting victory. The winner gave his trainer his first Breeders' Cup score; jockey Jose Santos picked up his sixth. "He's a late-developing type coming into his own this year," said trainer Mark Frostad. "Chief was difficult to beat on this day. He's getting better and better." The runner-up, third in the Arc in her latest, just missed. "She got the run of the race and the splits in the straight, but the ground is quite firm and she started to hang left," said her jockey, European champion Kieren Fallon. "She accelerates better when it's not as firm as this. She'll be a much better filly next year." Chief Bearhart bettered the old mark of 2:24 set by Fraise at Gulfstream in 1992.

Trainer Pat Byrne, enjoying his first Breeders' Cup Championship, saddled his second winner from three starters on the day. After pocketing the Juvenile Fillies with Countess Diana, Byrne had said, "You can never sit on your laurels in this business. You don't know what's round the corner. You have to keep rolling with it." And roll he did, saddling Favorite Trick in his bid to become only the second two-year-old in racing history to be named Horse of the Year. The colt rode into the Juvenile on a seven-race winning streak and rode out with a record of eight-for-eight. Rated just off the leaders through the opening fractions, the winner of the GI Hopeful and GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity in his last two starts launched his bid from the rail as they raced into the final bend to take command after three-quarters in 1:09 2/5, and galloped away to a stakes record and a certain Eclipse Award as top two-year-old; it remains to be seen if he can follow the immortal Secretariat, who earned the 1972 Horse of the Year Award at two. "He won a big race here beating a couple of new shooters," said Byrne. Asked what's next, he replied, "You hate to stop when they're doing so well, but we decided to pull his back shoes and give him six weeks off for a vacation in Ocala." Favorite Trick broke the Juvenile record of 1:41 3/5 set by Unbridled's Song at Belmont Park in 1995; he gave jockey Pat Day a record ninth Breeders' Cup win. The crowd's second choice, GI Futurity and GI Moet Champagne victor GRAND SLAM (Gone West), had his heels clipped by JOHNBILL (Slew City Slew) on the first turn and was then wide throughout; he was eased in the drive and came back with a deep cut on his left hind leg. "He tore a couple of chunks out of his hock," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who has won the Juvenile five times but this time trailed the field with his three entries. "I've never seen an injury like it before."

Giving the Niarchos family its third victory in the Mile, deserving favorite Spinning World settled just off the lead under a patient Cash Asmussen, moved to challenge pacesetter LUCKY COIN (Chas Conerly) at the head of the lane, swept past the front-runner and drew away with authority. Three-for-four on the season coming into this year's edition, the four-year-old improved off a second-place finish to Da Hoss in the Mile last year. His time of 1:32 2/5 equalled both the course and stakes record, set by Royal Heroine (Ire) in the 1984. "I thought he would be much better as a four-year-old," said winning trainer Jonathan Pease, who saddled Tikkanen to take the 1994 Breeders' Cup Turf. "I was pleased with the draw; everything worked out." It was the seventh time a European invader has taken this race, but the victory was most important to Asmussen, who broke an 0-for-22 Breeders' Cup streak. "I rode him like he was the best and he didn't let me down," said Asmussen. "He ranks as the best. He's a fine Bordeaux that gets better every time you taste it." The Niarchos colorbearer Miesque won this event in 1987 and 1988. Geri closed to take the three-way photo for second over the late-running Decorated Hero (GB), who now heads for Hong Kong, and Lucky Coin. HELMSMAN (El Gran Senor) was in traffic early and had no rally, finishing 10th. He pulled up lame and was vanned off. "It was not life-threatening," said his jockey, Corey Nakatani. "He pulled up a little off and I just jumped off." Trainer Wally Dollase confirmed that his five-year-old had suffered a bowed tendon.

Another champion was crowned in the Distaff as Ajina, already winner of the GI Mother Goose and GI Coaching Club American Oaks and runner-up to HIDDEN LAKE (Quiet American) in the GI Beldame in her latest October 19, overtook front-running Sharp Cat from the inside and edged away to a divisional Eclipse Award. The three-year-old filly, the fourth to best the older mares in the Distaff, gave jockey Mike Smith his seventh Breeders' Cup win and trainer Bill Mott his fourth. "I felt confident going in," said Smith. "Mott and crew do a fabulous job--you know you have a good shot. The pace was quick. I wasn't too far off it going down the backside. When we passed Sharp Cat, my filly thought, 'hey, this is fun,' but I never stopped riding." "Looks like this race could wrap up the Eclipse Award," said Mott. "I don't think they can deny her now. We'll send her to Payson Park to give her 30 to 60 days off. She'll probably come back in the late spring in New York." Sharp Cat cut out torrid early fractions of :45 4/5 and 1:09 1/5, the fastest in the history of the event, but the filly was only one-for-four at a mile and an eighth coming into this race and could not sustain her speed to the wire while holding on for second. Part of an entry with last year's Distaff heroine JEWEL PRINCESS (Key to the Mint) favored at even-money, she completed the first-ever three-year-old filly exacta in the Distaff. Her entymate, however, showed little and was eased late. "She's okay," said trainer Wally Dollase. "She just didn't have it today. (Jockey Corey Nakatani) thought, rather than push her, he'd pull her up. It's her last race." Second choice Hidden Lake, winner of four straight coming into this test, never got untracked and finished seventh. "She just ran a flat race," said jockey Richie Migliore. "I never felt like we were going well. She never jumped into the bridle. By the middle of the backstretch I was asking her to run, but she wasn't giving me anything."

Following a record-setting Juvenile Fillies, seven-year-old longshot Elmhurst was not to be outdone, skimming the rail to the stretch before switching to the outside and running down Hesabull in the final jumps to take the Sprint in a time one tick faster than the previous mark set by Thirty Slews at Gulfstream in 1992. Winner of the Gill Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita October 11 in his very first start at six furlongs, the late-blooming sprinter, a maiden until he was five, gave trainer Jenine Sahadi her second straight Sprint victory; Sahadi had become the first woman to saddle a Breeders' Cup winner when she sent out Sprint hero Lit de Justice at Woodbine last year. "This win is special because it occurred here at Hollywood Park," she said. "All my friends are here; I get to go home to my own bed. I'm grateful to all the guys and girls who work for me. I couldn't do it without them. They deserve all the credit." As for the future, she said, "Our goal is to keep Elmhurst around as long as possible. We want to have fun with him." And the immediate future? "Champagne. That's the answer to the question--what am I drinking tonight?" It was also the second Sprint win in a row, and the third Breeders' Cup win overall, for jockey Corey Nakatani, who guided favored Lit de Justice from last to first in 1996. Elmhurst, whose sire Wild Again won the inaugural Classic at Hollywood in 1984, becomes the third gelding to win the Sprint, following Thirty Slews and '93 champ Cardmania. Cal-bred **MEN'S EXCLUSIVE** (Exclusive Ribot), the slight 3-1 favorite, pressed the pace but weakened late and finished sixth. Second choice **RICHTER SCALE** (*Habitony) was never in the hunt and ended up 13th.

Countess Diana zipped through fractions of :45 4/5 and 1:09 2/5 in her first try around two turns, the Gill Walmac International Alcibiades S. at Keeneland October 11, and held on, leg-weary but game, for the victory. Tracking pacesetter **BAY HARBOR** (Forty Niner) through only a slightly less blazing half in :46 at Hollywood, the slight 2-1 choice this time powered to the lead after six furlongs in 1:10 2/5 and showed no signs of tiring down the lane. This year's champion two-year-old filly-elect widened her advantage with every stride to capture the Juvenile Fillies in the fastest time in 11 runnings of the race at this distance, taking two-fifths off the record set by My Flag at Belmont Park in 1995, and by the widest margin in the race's history. It was trainer Pat Byrne's first Breeders' Cup starter, and the first BC winner for jockey Shane Sellers. "Winning this has been a great team effort," said Byrne. "Countess Diana is a super filly. We feel fortunate to have her. This has been a great year for me and my family, which we hope to translate into more great years." Added Sellers, "I really think she liked the racetrack. She was very comfortable. I was able to sit off the speed. She's very hard to outrun." Career Collection, the second choice after a nine-length score over Cal-breds in the Cal Cup Juvenile Fillies just two weeks ago, made a run at the winner at the top of the lane but was no match while clearly second best.
