KEENELAND NOVEMBER STARTS

TODAY Keeneland's 1997 November Breeding Stock Sale kicks off in Lexington today with a record 4,162 horses catalogued for the 12-day auction. Headlining the offering are 2,113 broodmares in foal to star stallions such as A.P. Indy, Caerleon, Danzig, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Mr. Prospector, Rainbow Quest, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold, Storm Cat and Woodman; and 1,794 weanlings by top sires like Caerleon, Deputy Minister, Fairy King, Gone West, Mr. Prospector, Nureyev, Sadler's Wells, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold, Storm Cat and Woodman. Also included in the catalogua are broodmare prospects, stallions and stallion prospects, yearlings and horses of racing age. Highlighting Monday's opening session are the dispersals of Thomas Mellon Evans' Buckland Farm, the estate of R. E. Hibbert, Ross Valley Farm and Atwood Richards. Evans passed away in July; the 124-horse Buckland consignment, with Lane's End as agent, offers weanlings, yearlings, broodmare and broodmare prospects, and racing and stallion prospects. Last year's November Sale saw 2,830 horses sell for \$170,925,800, an average of \$60,398. The sales topper was Mariah's Storm (Rahy), a multiple graded-stakes winner in foal to Storm Cat who brought a bid of \$2.6 million from a group headed by John Magnier. She was sold by Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent for Thunderhead Farms. The 1997 Keeneland November Sale runs through November 21, with bidding beginning at 10 a.m. daily.

MINOR SURGERY FOR GRAND SLAM MGISW Grand Slam (Gone West), eased as the 2-1 second choice in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Hollywood Park Saturday, underwent minor surgery Sunday morning to clean and examine the deep wound on the back of his left hind leg suffered when Johnbill (Slew City Slew) clipped his heels on the first turn. "They're going to put him on the table under anesthesia so they can clean it properly," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas before the procedure, which was performed at the equine medical center in Cypress, California. "Infection is a concern, so we want to make sure we get the wound clean. Once they get into that, they can determine the extent of the damage. Preliminary thoughts are there was no tendon or joint damage. But it was the worst (injury of its type) I've ever seen." Asked if the colt would race again, Lukas said, "I asked (the vets) that and at this point they're optimistic, but they want to reserve an opinion." (Breeders' Cup wrap-up cont. p2)

Lord Of Men (GB) set the pace, with Taipan sitting third along the rail; he was joined by Oxalagu early in the straight and both quickened. The German horse looking the probable winner, but Taipan produced a fine turn of foot inside the final furlong to settle the issue and win easily, supplementing his victories in the G1 Grand Prix de Deauville at the end of August and the G1 EMS Kurierpost Europa-Preis in September.

BREEDERS' CUP WRAP-UP Classic champion Skip Away (Skip Trial) came back from his impressive score in good order and will now get a break in sunny Florida before preparing for a five-year-old campaign. "We plan to race him next year as long as he stays competitive." said trainer Sonny Hine, "We like to see him run," Chief Bearhart (Chief's Crown), rallying winner of the Turf, was also in fine fettle after his Breeders' Cup victory and will ship to Florida Monday, first flying to Miami before vanning to Ocala for some R & R. Trainer Pat Byrne's pair of two-year-old champs, Juvenile hero Favorite Trick (Phone Trick) and Juvenile Fillies winner Countess Diana (Deerhound), will join Chief Bearhart and Skip Away aboard the Tex Sutton charter to Florida this morning. Distaff heroine Ajina (Strawberry Road {Aus}) will also be on that plane. She will be freshened in Florida and is expected to be back in action next spring at four. Mile champ Spinning World (Nureyev) had his swan song in the Breeders' Cup and headed to Kentucky Sunday morning. He will stand the 1998 breeding season at Ashford Stud in Versailles. The seven-year-old gelding Elmhurst (Wild Again), who took the Sprint with an explosive last-to-first move, will race again at eight. "If he's happy and healthy, we hope to give it a whirl in the Breeders' Cup again next year," said trainer Jenine Sahadi. Turf runner-up Borgia (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) will race again next year as a fourvear-old. Owner Dietrich von Boetticher said vesterday. "(Chief Bearhart) was a little better than my filly--Saturday. She was the best horse in Germany this year. It has all been a great experience. Her season and this experience is a big boost for German racing and should encourage future (Breeders' Cup) participation from there." Trainer Wally Dollase said yesterday that Jewel Princess (Key to the Mint), eased in the Distaff, was not seriously injured. "She was going well until the quarterpole," said Dollase. "Then she was not trying hard. She has some cartilage damage to her ankles that stung her." The five-year-old will go to the breeding shed as planned. Stablemate Helmsman (El Gran Senor), vanned off after finishing 10th in the Mile, suffered "either a pulled ligament or a tendon tear," said Dollase. The fiveyear-old will take up stud duty at Adena Springs Farm in Versailles, Kentucky for 1998. Dollase also saddled Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister) to a second-place finish in the Classic and Career Collection (General Meeting) to run second in the Juvenile Fillies. Deputy Commander will get a month off on the farm in Bradbury, California, but Career Collection could be back for the GI Hollywood Starlet December 13, Saturday's common pool handle of \$67,096,241.90 at Hollywood Park was a Southern California and Hollywood record.

TOUCH GOLD OUT OF ACTION GI Belmont S. and GI Buick Haskell Invitational winner Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), ninth and last in Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, will be out of training for at least seven weeks after reinjuring his left front foot during the race. "We had to cut the whole quarter out last night, so he'll be off until at least January," said trainer David Hofmans yesterday. "He won't even go to the track until at least January. He hit his right tendon in a couple of spots and just knocked the hide off. It was nothing serious, thank God, but it could have been scary."

KINGMAMBO COLT TOPS FASIG-TIPTON SELECTED WEANLINGS A bay colt by Kingmambo out of graded stakes-winner With A Wink (Clever Trick) brought a final bid of \$122,000 to top the Selected Weanling session of the 1997 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Mixed Sale, held at Newton Paddocks in Lexington yesterday. Consigned by Akindale Farm with Lane's End as agent, the New York-bred was purchased by Gage Hill Stable. A total of 117 Selected weanlings sold Sunday, bringing an aggregate \$2,519,900 for an average of \$21,538. The average was down 10.7 percent from the corresponding session in 1996, when 108 hips sold for \$2,606,300, an average of \$24,132. The Fall Mixed Sale concluded last night with a session of Selected Broodmares. Fasig-Tipton will host the first annual sale featuring 89 mares in foal to Adena Springs stallions Birdonthewire, Demaloot Demashoot, Explosive Red, Foxtrail, Friendly Lover, Lit de Justice, Lite The Fuse and Wild Zone tonight, with bidding beginning at 8 p.m.

"He's got no excuses," said jockey Gary Stevens. "I have no idea why he ran like he did. He was running a nice race until the quarter pole, but he just collapsed underneath me." Aded Gary Mandella, assistant to trainer Richard Mandella, "I guess...we didn't have him as ready as we thought. He's doing really well, but I guess he deceived us a little. He wasn't as fit as he looked. But it's not that bad--this is a good building block."
