REMEMBERING "THE MASTER" Jockey Eddie Arcaro, who passed away Friday at the age of 81, was so much more to racing than what is written in the history books. He was more than his two Triple Crowns, more than the six-time leading rider in America, more than the man elected to the Hall of Fame in 1958. He hadn't ridden a race in more than 35 years, but "The Master" will long be remembered for his competitive fire on the racetrack and his grace as an ambassador to the sport after he hung up his tack. Bill Boland, now a steward, was the youngest jockey ever to win the Kentucky Derby when he took the 1950 "Run for the Roses" with Middleground at age 16. Arcaro had the call on that colt, but instead chose Hill Prince and finished second. "When I won the Derby he congratulated me--and then he said something like 'You little (bleep), any other time you would have moved a half mile too soon'," recalled Boland with a smile, "Eddie was the greatest rider I ever saw. Everybody knew him. He couldn't go anywhere without someone stopping him for an autograph." But woe to those who got in his way on the racetrack. Crowded at the start of a race in 1942, Arcaro went after the offending jockey and intentionally put him into the infield. While his aggressive riding style carried him to 4,779 victories, that time it cost him a one-year suspension. But his will to win never cost him the admiration of his fans. "When I was growing up in Puerto Rico, my father would tell me if I wanted to be a jockey, I had to learn to ride like Eddie Arcaro," said fellow Hall of Famer Angel Cordero Jr. "When I was 15, I met him...he gave me a pair of his goggles and, man, I wore them everywhere I went for two years. I'm very sorry he is gone, and I'm sorry that half the racetrack never got to see him ride. God only makes so many people like Muhammed Ali, Michael Jordan and Babe Ruth who can never be topped. Eddie Arcaro is right there. He was the best ever." Pat Lynch, a New York Racing Association vice president during Arcaro's heyday, said, "He reminded me of Joe DiMaggio. If DiMaggio was perfection at the plate. Eddie was perfection on a horse. He had the same combination of grace and elegance. He was a terrific guy." Bill Shoemaker was Arcaro's closest rival and one of his closest friends. The two faced off in a match race in 1955--Arcaro, aboard Nashua, gunned to the lead at the start, leaving Shoemaker and Swaps to play catch up. They never did. "He was a great friend, but when he got in the gate and the gate opened, he'd forget about that," said Shoemaker. "He was such a competitor. He never gave you an inch on the racetrack and that's what made him so great."

GULCH FILLY TOPS KEENELAND SATURDAY Elavsha (Gulch), a three-vear-old filly out of stakes winner and multiple graded-stakes placed Key Flyer (Niiinsky II), attracted the highest bid on the sixth day of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale Saturday in Lexington. Consigned by Mill Ridge Sales, agent, the broodmare prospect, who was unplaced in her only career start, was purchased by Wayne G. Lyster III for \$210,000. Saturday's session saw 276 horses sell for \$10,396,400. The average of \$37,668 was up 25 percent over the sixth session in 1996, while Saturday's median, \$30,000, was up 26 percent. A total of 298 horses brought \$8,986,000 for an average of \$30,154 during last year's corresponding session; the median was \$22,000. The 12-day auction continues through Friday, November 21, with bidding beginning at 10 a.m.


