RECORD DAY AT KEENELAND The November Breeding Stock Sale established an all-time Keeneland and industry record for gross sales Sunday with five days still remaining in the 12-day Lexington, Kentucky auction. Through Sunday, Keeneland sold 1,953 horses for \$197,867,300. This eclipsed the previous mark of \$191,957,900 for 1,881 horses and 95 stallion shares at the 1983 November Sale. Prior to 1984, Keeneland sales totals included all horses who failed to reach their reserve bid. "The record gross is a testimonial to the quality of the horses offered by our consignors and demonstrates enthusiasm for the Thoroughbred industry worldwide," said Keeneland director of sales Rogers Beasley. Top price at vesterday's session was paid for hip number 2313, a weanling by Mr. Greeley--Country Queen, by Explodent. Consigned by Highclere (Jeffry Morris), Agent V, the bay colt brought a final bid of \$130,000 from Tik Tik Trinidad. Gentry Brothers paid top price of \$102,000 for a broodmare, purchasing fouryear-old Up Dip (Kerosene), in foal to Twining, from Craig Bandoroff's Denali Stud, as agent. Keeneland sold 289 horses Sunday for \$8,330,200--up 18.3 percent from last year's aggregate of \$7,040,300 for 275 horses. The average rose 12.6 percent from \$25,601 last year to \$28,824 in 1997. The sale concludes Friday.

LONESOME GLORY WINS COLONIAL CUP Kay Jeffords's Lonesome Glory (Transworld) took dead aim on his fourth Eclipse Award with a half-length win over Rowdy Irishman (Erins Isle {Ire}) in the \$115,900 Colonial Cup Sunday at Springdale Race Course. Should the nine-year-old earn the 1997 title, he would join Flatterer (1983-86) as the only other four-time steeplechase Eclipse champion. The victory, with bonus awards, was worth \$319,540 and boosted Lonesome Glory's lifetime earnings past the \$1 million mark--an American steeplechasing record. Rallying powerfully around horses on the final turn, Lonesome Glory reached the last of 17 fences on even terms with Master McGrath (Compliance) and Rowdy Irishman. The winner gained a narrow advantage in the final sixteenth-of-a-mile and held off Rowdy Irishman with Master McGrath third. "This was a very tough race for him," said trainer Bruce Miller. "Rowdy Irishman ran a great race and I'm honored to beat him. He might have deserved to win, but Lonesome is a good horse. I know I'll never be associated with another horse this good." The National Steeplechase Association annual championships were decided over the weekend. Bill Lickle took the owner's title: Tom Voss won his first trainer championship and Arch Kingsley and Jonathan Kiser shared the jockeys title.
