SANTA ANITA SETS STAKES SCHEDULE Santa Anita Park's 1997-98 winter/spring stakes schedule will be worth \$11,025,000 and include 10 Grade I races, 21 Grade IIs and eight Grade IIIs. Two of the marguis events on the 60-stakes program have been shortened. The February 7 GI \$500,000 Strub S., finale in the three-race Strub Series for four-year-olds, will be run at a mile and an eighth rather than a mile and a quarter; the January 17 GII San Fernando S. has been shortened a sixteenth and will be run now at a mile and a sixteenth. "Both races can now serve as more of a progression to our championship race, the Santa Anita H. (March 7)," said Thomas Robbins, Santa Anita's vice president of racing. "In the case of the Strub, it was asking a lot of good horses to go a mile and a quarter so early in the year, particularly just three months after the Breeders' Cup." The GI \$750,000 Santa Anita Derby is set for April 4. Purses for the GI Santa Monica, GI Santa Maria and GI Las Virgenes have been raised \$50,000 to \$200,000; the GI Santa Anita Oaks has been raised \$50,000 to \$250,000; and the GI La Brea has been upped \$25,000 to \$150,000. In accordance with recent legislation, the Santa Anita stakes schedule will also include 10 Cal-bred races worth \$1.1 million. The winter/spring meet runs December 26-April 20.

KEENELAND TOPS \$200 MILLION For the first time in its history, the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale topped the \$200 million mark with yesterday's eighth session in Lexington yesterday. At the conclusion of Monday's session, a total of 2,224 horses had sold for an auction-record \$203,574,600, an average of \$91,535. Yesterday's high seller was a weanling filly by Mr. Greeley out of SW Ivory Princess (Ire) (Cure the Blues). Consigned by Blackburn Farm (Michael T. Barnett), agent, the chestnut sold for \$117,000 to Sideral Stables. Keeneland sold 271 horses Monday for an aggregate \$5,707,300 and an average of \$21,060. The gross was up 31 percent over last year's corresponding session when 262 horses brought \$4,349,000; the average rose 26.8 percent over the 1996 eighth-session figure of \$16,599, while the median was up 6 percent, from \$16,000 last year to \$17,000 vesterday. There are four days remaining in the sale, which concludes Friday.

With the help of Karla lannucci, herself a horse owner, Sinclair located the owner of Known Ranger and raised \$1.500 through the Internet to buy the veteran campaigner. Bartzsch donated \$400 to the effort. Known Ranger was then given to ReRun, Kentucky's race horse adoption program, where he awaits his new home.
