### PEINTRE CELEBRE WINS CARTIER AWARD

French Derby and Arc de Triomphe winner **Peintre Celebre** (Nureyev) was named Horse of the Year at Wednesday's Cartier Racing Awards dinner in London, according to yesterday's *Racing Post*. The awards are determined by a combination of earned points in Pattern races, votes from journalists from four leading newspapers and from readers of the *Daily Telegraph*. The Cartier Award of Merit, determined by a 17-member panel, was given to retiring broadcaster Sir Peter O'Sullivan. Equine honors went to **Embassy (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) (two-year-old filly), **Xaar (GB)** (Zafonic) (two-year-old colt), **Ryafan** (Lear Fan) (three-year-old filly), **Peintre Celebre** (three-year-old colt), **Celeric (GB)** (Mtoto {GB}) (stayer), **Royal Applause (GB)** (Waajib {Ire}) (sprinter) and **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent) (older horse).

### GOFFS NOVEMBER SALES RESULTS

At yesterday's first session of the Goffs November Premier Foal and Breeding Stock Sale in Kildare, Ireland, top price was paid for hip number 96. The bay colt by Marju (Ire) --Houwara (Ire) (Darshaan) was consigned by Grove Lodge, agent and was purchased by T. Twoomey for \$65,070. At Thursday's session, 158 horses sold for a total of \$1,758,623 and an average of \$11,130. The sale continues today at 10 a.m. and runs through Sunday.

### BREEDERS' CUP WAGERING UP

Total wagering on the seven Breeders' Cup Championship races on November 8 was \$72,659,391, the fourth highest of all time. The figure represents a 7.3 percent increase from 1996. Included in the total is the \$63,447,847 bet at a North-American record 923 simulcast and off-track betting locations and the \$9,211,544 handled at Hollywood Park. The Breeders' Cup Pick 6 generated \$3,379,014 in bets--a 24-percent increase over last year's Pick 7. The 115 winning tickets returned \$16,417 each. Total North American wagering on the 10-race Hollywood program was \$79,741,030, of which \$19,995,723 was bet in the state of California and \$10,364,235 was handled in the state of New York. "We are pleased with our continued growth in overall wagering during the past two year and the positive response to the new Pick 6 in the U.S.," said D. G. Van Clief, Jr., president of Breeders' Cup Limited. "We greatly appreciate the participation of racing fans throughout the world who continue to make the Breeders' Cup Championship racing's greatest day."

### KEENELAND THURSDAY WRAP-UP

Flowers Kris S. (Kris S.), a 12-year-old broodmare in foal to Stalwart, brought a top price of \$85,000 during Thursday's session of Keeneland's November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington, Kentucky. John O'Meara bought the dark bay mare from Taylor Made Sales Agency, as agent. Flowers Kris S. is the dam of multiple stakes winner **Nonproductiveasset** (Stalwart). During yesterday's 11th session of the sale, Keeneland sold 190 horses for \$2,257,900, an average of \$11,884. The aggregate is up 95.3 percent from last year's corresponding figure of \$1,156,400. The average marked a 76.8-percent increase over last year's figure of \$6,723. The median price of \$8,350 was up 98.8 percent from 1996's \$4,200. The sale concludes today.

**CHURCHILL RACE RULED 'NO CONTEST'** The seventh race at Churchill Downs yesterday was declared a "no contest" after Picture Hat bobbed at the start, throwing Shane Sellers to the ground and appearing to kick the prone jockey in the head. Sellers lay motionless on the track while the race proceeded, forcing the out-riders to order the rest of the jockeys to pull up before completing the 1 1/8-mile race. Sellers was examined by Churchill Downs physicians and complained of pain in the back of his head. He was taken by ambulance to Caritas Medical Center for further examination and was treated and released. All wagers on the seventh race were refunded, with the exception of the Pick Six and Pick Three betting. The Pick Six pool, \$46,440.32 leading into yesterday, was carried over to today's card. All wagering on the Pick Six from Thursday was paid to holders of tickets with five wins for a return of \$23,389.50. Pick Three wagers paid off for ticket holders with the correct selection in the two remaining races on their tickets. Picture Hat was not injured in the incident.

**FOX TO BROADCAST SANTA ANITA DERBY** In its first foray into the world of horse racing, Fox Sports has secured the exclusive broadcast rights to the 1998 GI Santa Anita Derby. The Santa Anita Derby, broadcast on ABC since 1981, will be run Saturday, April 4. "We are thrilled to establish a new relationship with FOX Sports for coverage of the Santa Anita Derby," said Clifford Goodrich, president and Chief Operating Officer of the Los Angeles Turf Club, Inc. "We've enjoyed our one-show-a-year arrangement with ABC Sports, but this opportunity seems like a natural progression given the programs from Santa Anita already telecast in Southern California on FOX Sports West and FOX Sports West 2." The one-hour Santa Anita Derby telecast on FOX will air at 5 p.m. ET/2 p.m. PST.
