ANTESPEND RETIRED *Antespend* (Spend a Buck), a Grade I winner on turf and dirt, has been retired from racing and has been shipped to Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky. The four-year-old filly will be bred to Storm Cat in 1998. Out of GI Matriarch and GI Ramona H. winner *Auspiciante* (Arg), *Antespend* won 10 of 24 starts and \$1,011,953. Among her seven stakes victories were the GI Del Mar Invitational Oaks on turf and the GI Santa Anita Oaks and GI Las Virgenes S. on dirt. The Kentucky-bred was purchased for \$900,000 by Chestertown Farm (Chester Broman) from the complete dispersal of the late Jack Kent Cooke's Elmendorf Farm at the 1997 Keeneland April sale. She was most recently trained by John Kimmel, who saddled her for her final career outing, a second-place finish in the GIII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont Sept. 14.

FAIRY KING COLT TOPS GOFFS FRIDAY A weanling colt by Fairy King--*Alamiya* (Ire) (Doyoun {GB}) brought a final bid of \$221,071 to top Friday's session of the Goffs November Premier Foal and Breeding Stock Sale in County Kildare, Ireland. Consigned by Ballysheehan Stud, the bay was purchased by Timothy E. Hyde, Esquire. A total of 184 horses sold for an aggregate \$3,793,936 yesterday, an average of \$20,618. The sale continues through Sunday.

STUD FEE SET FOR HELMSMAN Frank Stronach announced yesterday that GISW *Helmsman* (El Gran Senor) will stand the 1998 breeding season at Adena Springs Farm in Versailles, Kentucky for a fee of \$10,000, live foal. The five-year-old, who ended his career with a 10th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile November 8, retires with a record of six wins, seven seconds and three thirds from 21 career starts and earnings \$1,132,142. He will stand for the partnership of Stronach and Horizon Stable.

RECORD KEENELAND NOVEMBER SALE CONCLUDES The 1997 November Breeding Stock Sale ended Friday after breaking the all-time Keeneland records for gross sales and number of horses sold. During the 12-day auction, a total of 3,013 horses brought an aggregate \$213,857,800, an average of \$70,978. The previous record for gross sales was \$191,957,900, set during the 1983 Keeneland November Sale. The number of horses sold broke the old mark of 2,958, set at the 1995 September Yearling Sale. Despite selling 6.5 percent more horses this year, the average was up 17.5 percent from the 1996 figure of \$60,398. The median rose 20 percent, from \$25,000 a year ago to \$30,000 in 1997. Keeneland sold 11 horses for \$1 million or more. The sales topper was the 1996 champion two-year-old filly *Storm Song* (Summer Squall); consigned by Eaton Sales, agent for Dogwood Stable, the Eclipse winner was purchased for \$1.4 million by Jamie Carrion. Friday's final session saw 156 horses sell for \$1,276,900, an average of \$8,185 and a median of \$5,350. The session topper was the unraced two-year-old filly *Chi* (Silver Hawk), a racing or broodmare prospect. Consigned by Breckenridge Farm LLC, agent, the bay daughter of MGSW *Barbarika* (Bates Motel) brought a bid of \$45,000 from Dr. Smiser West.

Local News: Oaklawn Park

Two opening-week feature races for three-year-olds, the Dixieland and Dixie Belle, have been restored to stakes status for Oaklawn Park's 1998 live racing season which begins January 30. The two events had originally been eliminated to keep Oaklawn's purse distribution within the guidelines agreed upon between the track and the horsemen, but Bill Walmsley, president of the National Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, encouraged track officials to restore the races to the schedule. The 19th edition of the Dixie Belle will be run January 30, while the 62nd Dixieland S., the oldest continually run stakes at Oaklawn, will be run January 31.

MGSW Crafty Friend (Crafty Prospector), 12th in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, worked five furlongs in 1:00 4/5 Friday and could make his next start in the GIII Native Diver H. going a mile and an eighth at Hollywood December 21. **GISW Swiss Yodeler** (Eastern Echo), prepping for the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood December 6, breezed five-eighths in :59 3/5 yesterday.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien, who saddled **Desert King (Ire)** (Danehill) to victories in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Irish Derby this year, could have his first American Classic runner next season, according to yesterday's *Racing Post*. O'Brien may send **Saratoga Springs** (El Gran Senor), winner of the G1 Racing Post Trophy October 25, to Churchill Downs for the 1998 Kentucky Derby. "He looks the right type of horse for the race," O'Brien told the *Racing Post*. "He has plenty of speed, and if we're going to have a runner in the race, he's more likely than any of the other (two-year-olds)."
