NUMBERS UP AT GOFFS NOVEMBER SALE

Through the first three days of the Goffs November Premier Foal and Breeding Stock Sale, which concludes today in County Kildare, Ireland, 436 horses have sold for \$8,276,730. Gross sales are up 12 percent from last year's auction, which saw 425 hips bring an aggregate \$7,402,350 during its three-day run. The 1997 average of \$18,984 is up 9 percent from \$17,417 a year ago, while the median has risen 3 percent, from \$12,026 in 1996 to \$12,380 this year. The unraced three-year-old filly **Dathiyana (Ire)** (Kris {GB}--Dafayna {GB}), by *Habitat topped Saturday's third session. A racing or broodmare prospect, the bay was consigned by Gilltown Stud as the property of H.H. The Aga Khan's Studs S.C. and purchased for \$134,410 by B.B.A. Ireland. The second highest bid of the day came in for a weanling filly by Machiavellian--Crystal Cup (Nijinsky II). A half-sister to champion English sprinter Iktamal (Danzig Connection) and GSW Rockamundo (Key to the Mint), she was consigned by Green Ireland Properties Ltd. Stud Farm and purchased for \$132,643 by Brian Grassick Bloodstock. Bidding for today's final session begins at 11 a.m.

DANCE DESIGN STARS AT TATTERSALLS

DECEMBER Classic winner **Dance Design (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), one of 2,587 lots catalogued, will headline the 10-day Tattersalls December Sales which begin Monday at Park Paddocks in Newmarket, England. A champion in Ireland at two and three, she captured the G1 Irish Oaks in 1996 and was twice a Group 2 winner in Ireland this year, defeating Japan Cup hopeful Oscar Schindler (Ire) in the Tattersalls Gold Cup in May. The four-year-old finished 11th in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf last out for a record of seven wins from 16 starts and earnings of \$664,337; she sells Wednesday, December 3. "Dance Design is a rare jewel to sell at public auction," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. More than 1,300 mares in foal to top stallions such as Caerleon, Danehill, Fairy King, Mark Of Esteem (GB), Rainbow Quest and Sadler's Wells will be on offer during the five-session Mares sale, which will run December 1-5. The four-day Foals sale is set for November 26-29. A total of 973 weanlings representing top stallions such as Caerleon, Fairy King, Lure and Sadler's Wells have been catalogued. The auction kicks off with the one-day Yearlings sale November 30, which will offer 234 lots, including those by Cadeaux Genereux (GB), Caerleon, Danzig, Diesis (GB), Lure and Sadler's Wells.

Five-year-old **Pilsudski (Ire)** (Polish Precedent) makes his final racetrack appearance before heading to stud in Japan. The winner of the 1996 G1 Breeders' Cup Turf and runner-up in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe the last two years has three Group 1 wins to his credit this year after taking the Coral-Eclipse S., Irish Champion S. and the Dubai Champion S. in his latest October 18. Four-year-old filly **Air Groove (Jpn)** (Tony Bin {Ire}) is undefeated in three starts this year and beat the boys in the G1 Tenno Sho in her latest October 26. **Oscar Schindler (Ire)** (Royal Academy), winner of the G1 Irish St. Leger in September, was fourth in the Arc and third in the G1 Prix Royal Oak last out October 26.

Instant Friendship, winner of the Oct. 12 Empire Classic H. for New York-breds and runner-up in the Oct. 18 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup over the Belmont main track, benefitted greatly when this race was taken off the grass and the field scratched down to five. The prohibitive favorite raced just behind the early leaders, surging to the front at the top of the lane en route to an easy victory. "The first part of the race I wanted to get a good hold of him and he even took himself back a bit," winning jockey John Velazquez said. "But on the backside he wanted to get in the clear, and I really didn't want to rush him. He wanted to run and when I tried to hold him back he threw up his head and I let him go. He's been calming down and with time he's going to get better and better." Trainer Leo O'Brien was happy with the stormy weather. "We felt really good when this race was taken off the turf because that's what we were hoping for right from the start, it all went according to plan," he said. "This race was important because his next race (Dec. 26 in Saudi Arabia) is a mile-and-seven-eighths. He needed a long race and that's what he got. Our main goal over there is the King's Cup in March."

"He was boxed in, but when he got racing room he accelerated very quickly," said winning trainer Neil Drysdale. "Last time he got completely boxed in. He was trapped the whole time and never got a run." Added jockey Gary Stevens, "This horse makes you work for it. He keeps you alert. Last time, I never got a chance to let him run because he was blocked the entire trip. Today we found a seam and he made the lead real quick. When he did, he started gawking around. I reached back and tapped him once or twice and he shied. I grabbed him, hit him left-handed to correct him and he ducked out into the middle of the track. But he's a real talented little horse with a good future ahead of him."

Jockey Larry Attard, a 24-year veteran of Canadian racing, has retired. The 45-year-old, who earned his first win in 1973, hangs up his helmet after amassing a record of 2,366 victories, 2,342 seconds and 2,382 thirds from 19,124 mounts and earnings in excess of \$34.2 million. Attard immigrated to Canada from Malta in the early 1970s and went on to win the Sovereign Award as Canada's top rider in 1983 and again in 1986. He captured the 1983 Queen's Plate with Bompago. A concussion suffered when his final mount, Imperial Canadian, fell during Woodbine's third race August 28 prompted the retirement. Attard will be honored during a ceremony at Woodbine November 30.
