PILSUDSKI PREVAILS IN JAPAN CUP In

what was the swan song of an illustrious career, fiveyear-old Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent) burst from the pack in the final furlong to take yesterday's \$2,702,743 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse by a neck. The world traveller, winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Woodbine and a Group 1 race in Germany last year, captured the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. in England and the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown this season before running second for the second straight year in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. But the consistent bay, on the board in 17 of his 22 career starts, came back to win the G1 Dubai Champion \$. at Newmarket October 18 and he finished his career with a flourish, surging past the Japanese filly Air Groove (Jpn) (Tony Bin {Ire}) to give trainer Michael Stoute his second straight Japan Cup. "I am very fortunate to have been able to win with two determined and wonderful horses," said Stoute, who took this race with Singspiel (Ire) last year and becomes the first conditioner to win the event twice. "But this victory would not have been possible if not for the wonderful teamwork from all of Pilsudski's staff." Purchased for stud duty by the Japan Racing Association in September, Pilsudski retires with a record of 10 wins, six of them Grade or Group One, from his 22 starts and earnings of \$4,443,868.

AFFIRMED FILLY TOPS GOFFS NOVEMBER

FINALE Movie Legend (Affirmed), a four-year-old filly in foal to Alzao, brought a bid of \$265,285 to top the final session of the Goffs November Premier Foal and Breeding Stock Sale in County Kildare, Ireland yesterday. Consigned by Moyglare Stud Farm, the unraced daughter of U.S. champion two-year-old filly Talking Picture (Speak John) was purchased by Barronstown Stud. A total of 834 horses sold for \$13,528,676 during the four-day auction. Last year's three-day Goffs November Sale saw 691 horses bring a total of \$10,462,860. The 1997 average of \$20,530 was up 15 percent from \$17,824 a year ago, while the median, \$13,264, rose 10.2 percent from the 1996 figure of \$12,026.

Sent off the third choice behind favored locals Bubble Gum Fellow (Jpn) and Air Groove (Jpn), Pilsudski (Ire) settled in seventh along the rail until deep stretch, then came with a late kick to outgame Air Groove in the final yards and take the photo. The filly seemed certain to win the day for the home team until the final yards, but Pilsudski found another gear and charged past for a narrow score. "I was maybe one horse behind the position I wanted going into the first turn, but I didn't panic," said jockey Mick Kinane, winning his first Japan Cup. "I was able to get to the inside on the turn and get a good position. We caught Air Groove at the last furlong and we had a battle until the last 100 yards. Then I was sure I had it won." Pilsudski gave England its third win in this event, following Jupiter Island (GB) in 1986 and Singspiel (Ire) in 1996. Attendance at Tokyo Racecourse Sunday was 151,994, down 3 percent from last year, but the day's handle, \$380,586,675, was up 2.7 percent. Handle on the Japan Cup, \$266,101,667, was up 4.6 percent.

HALL OF FAMER PINCAY TO MOVE TACK Hall of Fame jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., who needs another 269 victories to tie Bill Shoemaker's all-time win record of 8,833, will move his base of operations from the tough Southern California circuit this January. Pincay, who turns 51 December 29, will join either the Northern California or Washington lockey colony next year as he pursues Shoemaker's record. "I'm going to have to move, things aren't getting any better here," said Pincay, who has only two wins from 32 mounts at the current Hollywood Park meet. "I think I'll probably go to Northern California. I like San Francisco and I have a lot of friends there. Washington only races four days a week, and that makes it harder with my weight." Pincay, a native of Panama who came to the U.S. in 1966, is the only five-time winner of the Eclipse Award as top jockey; he has seven Breeders' Cup races, three Belmont Stakes and the 1984 Kentucky Derby, which he won with Swale, to his credit. His mounts have earned more than \$196.5 million.

WHITE FILLY MAKES DEBUT Patchen Wilkes Farm's hombred Patchen Beauty (Hatchet Man), only the ninth white Thoroughbred ever registered in the 103-year history of The Jockey Club, rallied to finish fifth in her racing debut at Churchill Saturday. Sent off at 7-1, the two-year-old finished 12 lengths behind the winner in the seven-furlong maiden special weight test. "She made a pretty good move there," said her trainer, Steve Morguelan. "I would hope that the race would help her and when she runs around two turns, she would improve off that race. We'll see in about three weeks at Turfway."
