TATTERSALLS DECEMBER SALES UNDERWAY

An offering of 234 yearlings kicked off the 10-day Tattersalls December Sales yesterday at Park Paddocks in Newmarket, England. Three lots brought \$141,485 to top the opening session. The first was a colt by Salse--Stardyn (GB) (*Star Appeal); the half-brother to MGSW Young Ern (GB) (Efisio {GB}) was consigned by Pine Ridge Farm, Ltd. and purchased by Darley Stud Management Co., Ltd. The second, a filly by Danzig out the MGISW Some Romance (Fappiano), was consigned by Ted Voute, agent, and purchased by Ashtown House Stud. Rathbarry Stud, Ireland, agent, sold the final session topper, a filly by Barathea (Ire) out of SW Frendly Persuasion (GB) (General Assembly), to Mrs. A. Skiffington. A total of 172 lots brought \$4,157,731 Monday. The average, \$24,173, was up 33 percent from last year. The 1996 Tattersalls December Yearling session saw 288 horses sell for \$5,233,375, an average of \$18,172. The auction continues Wednesday with the first of four weanling sessions. The five-day December Mares sale runs December 1-5.

TURFWAY OPENS SUNDAY Turfway Park opens for its 1997 Holiday Meet this Sunday, November 30. Several changes will greet visitors, including an innovative new look on the track's closed-circuit television system. Turfway has hired a new video vendor, the Charlson Group, which also produces the simulcasting programs for Ellis Park and Remington Park, and provides graphics systems to Santa Anita, Hollywood, Del Mar and Churchill Downs. In addition, Turfway has designated the fourth floor as its smoke-free area."The staff and management of Turfway Park are dedicated to providing the best customer service we possibly can," said President Mark Simendinger. The 22-day Holiday Meet will run through December 31, with first post Wednesdays through Fridays at 7 p.m. and Saturdays and Sundays at 1 p.m. The track's Winter/Spring Meet is set for January 1-April 2, 1998.
