SILVER CHARM HEADS WORLD CUP

NOMINEES Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Silver Charm (Silver Buck) heads a list of 84 international runners nominated to next year's third running of the Dubai World Cup. The first nomination stage for the March race closed November 19. Other American nominees include GI Travers S. winner Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister), Dowty (Irish River (Fr)) and Whiskey Wisdom (Wild Again). Representing the home team will be Godolphin's recent acquisitions Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), winner of the 1997 French 2000 Guineas and Starborough (GB) (Soviet Star), winner of the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot. There are entries from 13 different countries covering five continents. Notable European entrants include 1997 Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up Borgia (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) and additional Group winners Loup Sauvage (Riverman), Romanov (Ire) (Nureyev), Luso (GB) (Salse) and Oscar Schindler (Ire) (Royal Academy).

FAIR GROUNDS OPENS TODAY When racing returns to New Orleans's Fair Grounds today, fans will be able to enjoy the track's new \$34.5 million state-ofthe art grandstand and clubhouse. The new structure replaces the tents that had been in use at the track since a 1993 fire. "We've broken through to a new level of racing this year," said Fair Grounds President and General Manager Bryan Krantz. "Going back to marquee names of the sport and star quality, this is a new era for us here at the Fair Grounds." The track's 88-day meet runs through March 30 on a Thursday through Monday schedule. It will be closed Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Post time each day will be 12:30 p.m. CST. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas will, for the first time, send a string of 40 horses to the Fair Grounds and will be joined by top conditioners Bobby Frankel and Roger Attfield. Highlighting the stakes schedule are the \$500,000 GIII Louisiana Derby, to be televised live on ESPN March 15, \$300,000 GIII New Orleans H. and the \$200,000 GIII Fair Grounds Oaks.
