WORLD-RECORD WEANLING AT

TATTERSALLS A colt by Caerleon out of Doff The Derby (Master Derby), full brother to 1991 European champion three-year-old Generous (Ire), shattered the world record for a weanling sold at auction, bringing a bid of 2,500,000 guineas (\$4,421,425) at the Tattersalls December Sales yesterday in Newmarket, England. From the Barronstown Stud, Ireland, consignment, the bay, also a half-brother to MGSW Wedding Bouquet (GB) (Kings Lake) and three additional stakes winners, was purchased by Joss Collins of the British Bloodstock Agency on behalf of Satish Sanan's Padua Stables. A total of 192 weanlings sold for an aggregate \$13,872,662, an average of \$72,253, on the final day of Tattersalls December Foals sale. "The record price for the Caerleon colt was obviously the highlight of the first week of our December Sales, but should not completely overshadow what has been a highly rewarding week for breeders," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "A particular feature of this year's foal trade has been the greater involvement of end users, including prolific buying at all levels of the market from our large contingent of Turkish buyers, and increased demand from Japanese buyers at the top of the market. The strength of the market this week augers well for the mares and fillies to come." The five-day Mares sale begins December 1.

Devious Course was looking for his first stakes win since taking the GIII Nashua S. over this track three years ago. Now five, the bay picked up his first victory of the season in a one-mile Belmont allowance test two starts back, but weakened as the favorite going a mile and a sixteenth at Belmont last out October 18. Dropping back to a mile, he trailed the field through a half in :44.89 and was still 10th as the field hit the top of the lane, but came flying down stretch to catch Lucayan Prince at the wire. "I know my horse has a strong late kick, so I just wanted to wait for the right time," said winning jockey Jorge Chavez. "You can't rush this horse, you have to leave him alone. I was just hoping the speed horses would stop. If they did, great--if not, there wasn't anything I could do." Devious Course, recently purchased by Clarence Scharbauer Jr., ends his racing career on a winning note and now heads to Texas to stand at stud. **CRAFTY FRIEND** (Crafty Prospector), the slight 3-1 favorite, moved from just off the pace to put a head in front at the top of the stretch but couldn't hold on, finishing fourth.

Geri, winner of the GIC Woodbine Mile in September and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile last time out, was odds-on to end a great career on a winning note. Reserved off a moderate pace early, the crowd's choice made his move four-wide as they headed into the final turn, took control at the top of the stretch and edged clear late for the victory. "He was a little rank early because there was no pace," said rider Jerry Bailey. "I got him in the clear early in the race and it was academic from there on. He's going out on top of his game. I hate to see him go." Added trainer Bill Mott, "It's going to be hard to replace a horse like him. I think he has a good chance to make a good stallion, because he's such a good-looking horse--good quarters, good shoulders, muscular. This is a nice way to go out."

Clark Street broke her maiden by 12 lengths October 8 at Belmont and came back to win the GIII Selima S. at Laurel November 2 by seven, but just got up to take her third straight. The prohibitive favorite, she settled off the pace early, moved up along the rail on the far turn, then switched to the outside for the stretch drive and ran down Soft Senorita for a narrow score. "Let me tell you, she got an education today," said winning rider Mike Smith. "She's still a little green. She was trying to get out, so I went to the rail. I was wide on the first turn and didn't want to lose any more ground. I was a little bit boxed in, but I wanted to be there until the last minute." As for what's next, trainer Bill Badgett Jr. said, "We'll bring her to Ocala and give her a freshening for 30 to 40 days and then probably take the Hot Springs route (Oaklawn) with her because of John Ed Anthony." Anthony, Clark Street's owner, resides in Arkansas.

The battle for champion grass mare will be played out on the Hollywood Park turf course today, as **Maxzene** (Cozzene), **Memories of Silver** (Silver Hawk) and **Ryafan** (Lear Fan) all make their year-end bids for the award. Ryafan has won her only two U.S. starts, the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland Oct. 4 and the Nov. 2 GI Yellow Ribbon at Santa Anita. The only three-year-old in the race, she carries a four-race winning streak, including her final two starts in England, into this race. Memories of Silver comes off a bad trip when third in the Yellow Ribbon. Steadied sharply and forced into the rail near the eighth pole, the winner of the GI Beverly D. at Arlington Aug. 24 seeks to make amends for that disappointment. Maxzene, last seen when second in the GI Flower Bowl H. at Belmont Oct. 4, picks up rider Cash Asmussen here. The winner of the GII New York H. July 12 and the June 1 GII Sheepshead Bay H, both at Belmont, looks to earn her first Grade I win.
