CHURCHILL CONCLUDES FALL MEET Churchill Downs concluded its 108th Fall Meet Saturday with increases in attendance and wagering. During the 30day meet, the on-track attendance of 226,190 rose 1.8 percent from 222,225 a year ago. Wagering reached \$31,697,934, up 2.3 percent from the \$30,977,008 handled on-track in 1996. On Friday, Nov. 28, on-track and simulcast wagering on Churchill Downs racing established a new record. A total of \$10,129,228 was wagered at the Kentucky track and at hundreds of simulcast outlets on the 12-race card. That total eclipses a single-day record established on November 29, 1996 for the largest mutuel handle on a race day other than Kentucky Derby, Oaks or Breeders' Cup Day. On-track daily averages increased to 7,540 in attendance and \$1,056,598 in wagering. Factoring out Churchill's Breeders' Cup years (1899, '91 and '94), the increase in on-track daily average attendance was the first since 1990, while the gain in on-track daily average wagering was the first since 1986. Total wagering was \$178,146,645, a five-percent increase over last year's figure of \$169,544,123. "Our marketing strategy was invaluable in the success Churchill Downs achieved in both the spring and fall meets," said Churchill Downs President and Chief Executive Officer Thomas Meeker. "Reduced pricing and our continued commitment to customer service are vital in our efforts to retain patron base. The key to Churchill Downs future success will focus on our ability to react and compete with the changes that will take place in our market." Owner John Franks collected his fifth Churchill Downs leading owner's award with six wins. Trainer Neil Howard earned his first Churchill title as he collected 11 wins during the season to top Bobby Barnett in second with nine victories. Despite missing the final week of racing, Pat Day earned his 24th Churchill title with 44 victories.

KAWAHARA TAKES WORLD JOCKEY TITLE

Jockey Shoichi Kawahara of Japan's National Association of Racing claimed the 1997 title in the 11th annual World Super Jockeys Series at Hanshin Racecourse in Japan yesterday. Conducted over two days and four races, the series featured 13 top riders from around the world. Kawahara captured the title with two third-place finishes on the first day of competition before sweeping the final two races on Sunday. Japanese jockey Yutaka Take placed second and the top foreign rider was France's Olivier Peslier in third. Representing the United States, Pat Day finished seventh and Shane Sellers came in 12th.

Ryafan came into this race off two straight wins in North America--the Oct. 4 GI Queen Elizabeth at Keeneland and the Nov. 2 GI Yellow Ribbon at Santa Anita in her two lone U.S. starts, and clinched Eclipse Award honors as champion grass mare with this win over her two main rivals for the honor, Maxzene and MEMORIES OF SILVER (Silver Hawk). Reserved just off the pace of CHILE CHATTE (Storm Cat), she took the lead past the quarter pole, opened up daylight in the stretch, and was very game to hold off the late charge of Maxzene. "Right when I got to the quarter pole, she wanted the lead, but I wanted to wait a little longer to make sure I had enough horse at the end," said rider Alex Solis. Said Frankel, "She's probably the best I've ever trained." John Gosden, who trained Ryafan in Europe before turning her over to Frankel said, "Bobby and I are great old friends and have managed to combine quite effectively." Asked if she would now be heading to the breeding shed, he replied, "Hopefully not. The way she moved back there, I think she just could take to the main track. We'll talk to (Juddmonte owner) Prince Khalid (Abdullah) and make a decision." Maxzene, behind a wall of horses on the turn, found room in the stretch and slipped up the rail, but just fell short. "She ran a great race," said trainer Tom Skiffington. "I'm really proud of her. Cash gave her a great ride, but that's horse racing. She'll go home and have a rest. She's going to come back and race next year." Said Asmussen, "I think if we hadn't had traffic problems on the turn, we would have won. I'm sure everyone's just as disappointed as I was."

The New York trainer expressed some concern about the trip, however, when his colt drew the outside 14 post in a tough field of international competitors on a rained-softened course. Not to worry. Reserved off the early pace of FLEW THE CITY (Slew City Slew), Subordination was sent up after the lead on the turn, opened a clear advantage into the stretch, and held off the late charge of Lasting Approval to the wire. Bailey, in town to ride Memories of Silver (Silver Hawk), who finished 6th in the Matriarch, was grateful for the good luck. "You never know what's in store for you," said Bailey. "I had to pick this horse up on the spur of the moment, and it turned out to be my savior. I knew he was full of try and full of heart and it was certainly enough for today." Said trainer Gary Sciacca, "He's been a really nice horse. He won a couple of stakes in New York, and we decided to give him a shot. He deserved the opportunity to come out here."
