TATTERSALLS R E S U L T S

STRONG START FOR TATTERSALLS

DECEMBER MARES SALE Monday's opening session of the Tattersalls December Mare and Filly Sale, held in Newmarket, England, registered dramatic gains in both gross and average over last year's corresponding session. A total of 215 horses sold for \$21,613,824 yesterday, up 56 percent from 1996, while the average of \$100,529 jumped 57 percent and the 1997 opening-day median, \$58,410, rose 50 percent. Bringing the highest bid at the session was the racing or broodmare prospect **Rafina** (Mr. Prospector). The three-year-old filly, a full-sister to champions Machiavellian and Coup de Genie and half-sister to G1SW Exit To Nowhere (Irish River {Fr}), was consigned by Course Investment Corporation, France, and purchased for 700,000 guineas (\$1,238,000) by John Magnier. The five-day Mare and Filly Sale runs through December 5.

WHISKEY WISDOM TO WINDFIELDS FARM

GSW **Whiskey Wisdom** (Wild Again) has been retired due to a suspensory ligament injury and will go to stud next season at Windfields Farm near Oshawa, Ontario. The four-year-old won five of his six career starts, suffering his lone defeat in this year's G1 Breeders' Cup Classic, where he finished third but was disqualified and placed fourth in his final career start November 8. A winner from six furlongs to a mile and an eighth, he captured the GIII Fayette H. at Keeneland and bankrolled \$452,824. The Canadian-bred will stand as the property of Windfields Farm and Kinghaven Farms for a fee of \$7,500 (Canadian), live foal. "It is unfortunate that Whiskey Wisdom left the racetrack with his best performances perhaps still in front of him," said Kinghaven owner David Willmot, "but we are tremendously excited about his prospects as a sire." Added Windfields General Manager Bernard McCormack, "He has a very high-quality pedigree and near-perfect race record. Most importantly for breeders, he is almost a total outcross for most of today's popular bloodlines."

INTERNATIONAL RUNNERS ARRIVE IN HONG KONG A trio of horses representing England arrived in Hong Kong yesterday for the International Cup, Bowl and Vase, to be run December 14 over the Sha Tin turf course. **Wixim** (Diesis {GB}), running in the nine-furlong Cup; **Wizard King** (GB) (Shaadi), set for the seven-furlong Bowl; and **Luso** (GB) (Salse), headed to the mile-and-a-half Vase, touched down at 8:45 a.m. local time. The Australian contingent of Bowl runners **Catalan Opening** (NZ) (Kaaestad {NZ}) and **Spartacus** (Aus) (Snippets {Aus}) also shipped in Monday, arriving in the evening. Catalan Opening could give "Cup King" Bart Cummings, who has saddled the winners of 10 Melbourne Cups, his first success outside Australia. "I am confident he is going to be hard to beat," said the 70-year-old trainer. American hopefuls **Amarettitorun** (Ends Well), pointing for the Bowl, and **GISW Val's Prince** (Eternal Prince), the lone U.S. Cup representative, are scheduled to fly in to Hong Kong Wednesday. Completing the American team, Bowl candidate **White Bronco** (Houston) will arrive Friday and Vase runner **La Soberbia** (Arg) (Octante {Arg}) is set for a Sunday arrival.

Local News, Suffolk Downs

Maybe Jack (Classic Account) continued to pad his lead as the nation's winningest horse this year with a victory at Suffolk yesterday. The four-year-old gelding scored for the 12th time this season, taking a \$17,000 allowance event at the East Boston track. "We look at this as New England's horse," said owner John Buckley, Jr. "And it would be an honor and a pleasure if we can get another race in him over this track."

Local News: Canada

The Board of Trustees of the E.P. Taylor Equine Research Fund yesterday approved expenditures of nearly \$100,000 to help provide funding for seven research projects. The projects include two dealing with research into foal pneumonia and one each on allergic airway diseases, tying up, joint disease, fungal contamination of feed sources and bone response to fracture repair. EPTERF was created to honor E.P. Taylor when he retired as chairman of The Ontario Jockey Club in 1973. Since its inception, the fund has donated in excess of \$700,000 towards its ongoing commitment to provide financial support to research in Canada dedicated to the health and care of horses of all breeds.
