TATTERSALLS THURSDAY RESULTS Patrick Cooper of the BBA Ireland brought home the highest priced horse at yesterday's fourth session of the Tattersalls December Filly/Mare Sale in Newmarket, England. Cooper bought the three-year-old filly **Tobago Cayes (Fr)** (Nashwan) on behalf of Allan Lavin with a final bid of \$177,000. The broodmare prospect was consigned by Haras des Capucines. "This filly was bought to go to our stallion **Ide** (Forty Niner)," said Lavin. "We bought her on behalf of Ide's owner Peter Willmott." During Thursday's session, 220 horses sold for a total of \$4,563,060 and averaged \$20,740. The gross was up 51 percent from the corresponding 1996 session, while the average gained 34 percent. Tomorrow's final session of the sale begins at 9:30 a.m.

MEMORIES OF SILVER INJURED Multiple Grade I winner **Memories of Silver** (Silver Hawk) has suffered a hairline fracture in her left hind leg, her owner John Phillips confirmed yesterday. The fracture is not life threatening and plans for the four-year-old filly remain undecided. **Memories of Silver**, winner of this year's GI Beverly D. and the 1996 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, ran a troubled third after being bumped at midstretch in the GI Yellow Ribbon S. Nov. 2 and most recently finished sixth in Sunday's GI Matriarch. "Whether the injury was sustained in the Matriarch or was initiated as a result of the horrible collision in the Yellow Ribbon is impossible to say. The result is that she will be stall rested for 60 days before we make any decisions about her future. She has been wonderful to us and if there is any question as to her condition, she will be retired to Darby Dan Farm," said Phillips.

Local News, Thistledown:

Thistledown Racetrack recorded its best year ever for total handle in 1997, mainly due to full-card simulcasting. A total of \$205,450,013 was wagered at Thistledown from a combination of live racing, telephone account betting, full-card simulcasting and out-of-state money. It was the top dollar amount wagered in the track's 72-year history. Simulcasting accounted for \$86,898,489 from January 3 through November 30. A total of \$55,939,813 was wagered on the Ohio oval's 186 days of live racing--down 42.3 percent from 1996. The daily average handle in 1997 was \$300,752, down 39.5 percent from last year. The 1997 attendance totaled 664,613, down 13.1 percent. The daily average attendance in 1997 (3,573) saw an 8.9-percent decrease from 1996 (3,920). Mark Yagour won his third straight title as Thistledown's top owner in 1997. Gary Johnson earned top trainer honors and Jason Lumpkins was the top jockey.
