MACHIAVELLIAN FILLY TOPS STRONG

AGENCE FRANCAISE OPENER A weanling filly by Machiavellian--Party Doll (GB) (Be My Guest) brought a final bid of \$219,169 to top the opening session of the Agence Francaise Mixed Sale in Deauville, France yesterday. The full sister to MGSW Titus Livius (Fr) was purchased by Frederic Sauque. Horse France purchased the second highest-priced lot on the day, paying \$193,880 for a weanling colt by Sadler's Wells out of Dame Solitaire (Halo). A total of 89 horses sold for \$2,198,264 Saturday, up 38 percent from last year's opening session when 93 lots grossed \$1,588,468. The 1997 opening-day average of \$24,700 rose 45 percent, from \$17,080 a year ago. The three-day auction continues through Monday.

FULL FIELD SET FOR HOLLYWOOD TURF CUP

A full field of 12 looks likely to start in next Sunday's GI \$500,000 Hollywood Turf Cup. Heading the line-up is multimillionaire Sandpit (Brz) (Baynoun {Ire}), who will make his final start before heading to stud at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky. The eight-year-old, a champion in Brazil and five-time Grade I winner in the U.S., has earned \$3,763,301 to date. Trainer Ron McAnally will send out a pair of runners in Raipoute (Fr) (Double Bed {Fr}), a multiple Group 2 winner in France and sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last out; and the maiden Bonapartiste (Fr) (Kendor {Fr}). The latter, a three-yearold, is 0-for-13 in France but has been twice placed in Group races. "I don't know much about him, but he's done everything right so far," said McAnally. "His owner (Ecurie Fabien Quaki) sent him over a couple of weeks ago for this race. He looks like a nice horse." Also expected are: MGISW Awad (Caveat), Big Sky Chester (Afleet), Egipcio (GB) (Java Gold), Embraceable You (Fr) (Ti King {Fr}), MGSW Percutant (GB) (Perrault {GB}), Prize Giving (GB) (Most Welcome {GB}), GII Carleton F. Burke H. winner Prussian Blue (Polish Navy), MGSW River Bay (Irish River {Fr}) and GSW Talloires (Trempolino). Possible for the mile-and-a-half race are Da Bull (Country Pine), Flag Down (Deputy Minister), L'Africain Bleu (Fr) (Saint Cyrien {Fr}) and Shanawi (Ire) (Caerleon).
