TRIPLE DEAD-HEAT AT HOLLYWOOD

Just three races after the first-ever California walkover, Hollywood Park hosted another historical event as **Tina Celesta** (Falstaff), **Chans Pearl** (Pirateer) and **Cool Miss Ann** (Ice Age) finished in a triple dead-heat for the win in the fourth race yesterday. Tina Celesta, the 2-1 favorite, grabbed the lead on the far turn under jockey J. G. Matos and was two lengths in front at the eighth pole. But Cool Miss Ann, with jockey Matt Garcia up, and Chans Pearl, under Omar Berrio, were rallying and the three hit the wire together. The photo finish camera was unable to separate the trio, making for only the second triple dead-heat in Hollywood Park history--the first occurred July 3, 1957. Tina Celesta paid \$2.60 in the \$8,000 claiming event; Chans Pearl, who was claimed, returned \$2.80; and Cool Miss Ann paid \$4.00. "That's the great thing about racing, you never know for sure what is going to happen," said Pete Pedersen, a California Horse Racing Board steward who has been in racing for 60 years. "Strange things happen...that's why you're in the business."

AVERAGE UP AT AGENCE FRANCAISE MIXED SALE

After a strong opener, Sunday's second session of the three-day Agence Francaise December Sale in Deauville, France continued to show gains. A total of 94 lots sold yesterday for \$1,125,685, an average of \$11,975. The average was up 24 percent from last year's corresponding session when 125 horses brought \$1,206,609, an average of \$9,653. "We are clearly very pleased," said Philippe Augier, president of Agence Francaise. "We have succeeded in attracting buyers from all over the world despite the relative weakness of our catalogue. The proof is in the figures. Those who trusted the French market have been rewarded and I would like to thank them and congratulate them on their excellent results." Sunday's session topper was the 12-year-old broodmare **Light Of Hope** (Lyphard), in foal to Arc winner Saumarez. Consigned by Haras de Fresnay le Buffard, which sold Saturday's two session toppers as well, the mare, a winning full-sister to GSW and stallion Alzao, was purchased by Patrick Barbe for \$60,693. The Agence Francaise December Sale concludes today.

SHARP CAT WINS FIRST-EVER

CALIFORNIA WALKOVER With the field reduced by two late scratches, three-year-old filly **Sharp Cat** (Storm Cat) came home unchallenged in yesterday's GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park, winning the first walkover in California Thoroughbred racing history. Only eight horses had been nominated and only three were entered in the mile-and-a-sixteenth test, and trainer Ron McAnally opted to withdraw his two runners, **Toda Una Dama (Arg)** (Cipayo {Arg}) and **Alzora** (Seattle Slew), when the track came up wet. "I said all along there was a chance I could scratch both fillies because of the rain," said McAnally. "I think both fillies have a future next year, and I don't want to jeopardize their plans by running in the mud. Even though I think they can handle it, I'd rather not take the chance." The Thoroughbred Corp.'s Sharp Cat, runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff for trainer D. Wayne Lukas last out November 8, cruised around the track under jockey Alex Solis, covering the mile-and-a-sixteenth in 1:42 3/5 under 121 pounds. "No pressure whatsoever," said Solis. "I must be getting good at race riding, because I wasn't even nervous. I was told to go in a two-minute lick, but she wanted to go. Going into the first turn, I had a tight hold. She kept fighting me, so I let her run. She looked good, didn't she?" The last walkover in a major race came when Spectacular Bid took the 1980 Woodward S. at Belmont Park. The most recent saw Chinese Export win an allowance race at a hunt meet in Ligonier, Pennsylvania in 1982. The Bayakoa was the 31st walkover in American Thoroughbred racing history.

GOLDEN POND RETIRED Golden Pond (Ire) (Don't Forget Me {Ire}), who clipped heels and fell in the stretch of Saturday's \$100,000 My Charmer S. at Calder, was injured in the spill and will now be retired. "She broke a bone in the back of her left knee," said trainer Martin Wolfson. "The vets say that if a horse is going to break a bone, this one is in a good place because it is non-weight bearing. She also has a big hematoma on her chest, but that will be all right. This is tough to take. I thought she was running a winning race. She was going to be bred in the spring anyway, but I really wanted to run her in the La Prevoyante here (at Calder) and the Orchid again at Gulfstream before she went home. She could probably come back from this type of injury, but she would also have to get over it mentally and I just don't think there is enough time. I think Danzig is one of the stallions they are considering for her." The four-year-old filly, a stakes winner in France and first in this year's Gill Suwanee River H. and Gill Orchid H., retires with a record of seven wins from 24 starts and earnings of \$280,421.

FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC MIXED STARTS

STRONG The first session of the two-day Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Mixed Sale, held yesterday in Timonium, Maryland, posted a 41-percent increase in gross sales over last year's opener. A total of 234 horses brought an aggregate \$1,304,300 Sunday, up from 1996 when 172 lots sold for \$925,700. This year's average of \$5,574 was up 4 percent, from \$5,382 in '96. Bringing the highest bid during Sunday's session of broodmares, broodmare prospects, stallions and stallion shares was the six-year-old broodmare **Truth and Beauty** (Private Terms), in foal to Two Punch. The winning daughter of GSW La Reine Elaine (King's Bishop), consigned by Becky Davis, agent, was purchased for \$75,000 by the Northview Stallion Station. Today's final session of weanlings, yearlings and horses of racing age begins at 10 a.m.
