SURGERY FOR COUNTESS DIANA Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies champion **Countess Diana** (Deerhound) underwent surgery to remove a chip from her left knee, according to a report in the *Daily Racing Form*. "Both she and Favorite Trick underwent routine examinations after being sent to the farm in Ocala, which is when we discovered the chip," trainer Pat Byrne told the *Form* Thursday morning. "It wasn't a very big deal, just a little spur that popped off. When and where she did it I have no idea." Byrne added this year's likely two-year-old filly champion should return to the races by next spring, with the Kentucky Oaks her main goal.

'98 GRADED STAKES CHANGES ANNOUNCED

No changes were made to Grade I races, but the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders' Association North American Graded Stakes Committee has announced the upgrading of 30 races and the downgrading of 16 others. The Brown and Williamson Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill Downs, upgraded from Grade III to Grade II, is the only change among two-year-old events for either sex. Seven new Grade III events for three-year-old fillies, and four more for older fillies and mares, were announced. Three races for sophomore fillies were upgraded from Grade III to Grade II: the Davona Dale S. (Gulfstream Park), Honeymoon H. (Hollywood Park), and Mrs. Revere S. (Churchill Downs). Three new Grade III races for three-year-old males are the Crown Royal American Turf S. (Churchill Downs), Santa Catalina S. (Santa Anita), and Screen King S. (Saratoga); one turf stakes for older horses, the Robert F. Carey Memorial H. at Hawthorne Park, was also awarded GIII status. Two three-year-old stakes were upgraded to Grade II (the Riva Ridge S. at Belmont Park and San Vicente S. at Santa Anita), while nine events for older males were upgraded from Grade III to Grade II. The sponsorship package means that the added value of the Great Voltigeur will be increased by £10,000 (\$16,829) to £80,000 (\$134,635).

The Tampa Bay Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association has voted to align itself with the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association, which represents South Florida horsemen. According to FHBPA Executive Director Kent Stirling, "We've agreed to help their group with contract negotiations and they've agreed to combine their sign-up card with ours." By state law, the group which signs up the most horsemen gets to represent them at the contract table. TBHBPA President Leonard Alexander said his group hasn't signed a contract with the track for the current meeting which begins on December 21. Tampa Bay Vice President and General Manager John Grady offered the horsemen's group a contract that would set purses at 90 percent of what was paid out in 1997, or \$45,376 a day. Leonard said his group wasn't interested.
