NTRA NAMES BOARD OF DIRECTORS The Na-

tional Thoroughbred Racing Association took another significant step forward yesterday with the formation of a board of directors, the release of its business plan and the announcement that 34 NTRA membership agreements, representing 35 tracks, have been signed. Named to the NTRA Board, which consists of five racetrack representatives, five owners and/or breeders and a to-be-named CEO, were racetrack executives Bill Bork (Penn National), Doug Donn (Gulfstream Park), R.D. Hubbard (Hollywood Park), Tom Meeker (Churchill Downs), Kenny Noe (New York Racing Association) and horsemen's representatives Robert Clay, Alan Foreman, Ed Friendly, Ogden Mills Phipps and Bill Walmsley. D.G. Van Clief Jr., current interim CEO and president of the NTRA, will continue to serve in that role until a permanent CEO is named. The NTRA will begin in 1998 with a projected \$25 million in revenues and projected growth to \$40-43 million by 2001. The funding will come from contributions (30-35%), handle-based fees (20-25%), simulcast outlets such as OTBs and from miscellaneous sources such as licensing. The NTRA business plan calls for more than \$138 million to be spent for marketing and advertising Thoroughbred racing through a central national office over the next three years, following precedents set in other major North American sports. "I'm proud of U.S. racing today," Ogden Mills Phipps said. "We're always hearing that American racing is incapable of working together for the common cause. What has happened in the last few days, when all segments of our industry have rallied to the support of this worthy initiative, has proved otherwise." The NTRA Board of Directors holds its first meeting Monday.

MEADOWLANDS CANCELS AGAIN The second straight program at the Meadowlands was called off Friday due to unsafe track conditions, but officials are confident the New Jersey track will be back in action for its final 1997 card tonight. "We're optimistic," said Robert Kulina, vice president of Thoroughbred racing. "We'll make every effort to race. The weather looks better and the track should be able to dry out." **News cont. p2**

TRA AND JOCKEYS' GUILD EXTEND

AGREEMENT The Thoroughbred Racing Associations and the Jockeys' Guild concluded negotiations Thursday on a two-year extension of their agreement which assigns certain jockey media rights to the tracks. In return for those rights, the TRA will continue to provide accident insurance for the jockeys for \$100,000 in medical benefits and \$200 per week in disability payments for a maximum of two years. The agreement also specifies that tracks will increase their existing payments to the Guild by approximately \$300,000 over the two-year period. Those payments are used by the Guild to help subsidize its members health plan.
