**BAZE NOTCHES NUMBER 400** Russell Baze, the only jockey to win 400 or more races in a year more than three times, accomplished the feat for the sixth straight season at Golden Gate Fields Friday night. Baze guided 4-5 **Elusive Envoy** (Tally Ho The Fox) to a three-length victory in the sixth race of the night to pick up his 400th win this year. "I'm glad it's over," said Baze, but added, "It feels great. I love winning races." The 39-year-old rider, who became the 12th jockey in history to win 6,000 races December 3, began his streak with 433 wins in 1992 and followed with 410 in 1993, 415 in '94, 448 in '95 and 415 last year.

**MEADOWLANDS CANCELS FINAL CARD** Concerned that dropping temperatures would cause the track to freeze, officials called off Saturday night's final card at the Meadowlands. It was the third straight cancellation for the New Jersey oval. "We met with everyone concerned Saturday morning," said James Gagliano, general manager of administration and operations for the track. "We were unable to dry out the track satisfactorily and the prospect of a frozen track prompted the decision not to race." Average on-track attendance at the meet, which offered regular daytime racing on weekdays for the first time, showed a gain for the first time since 1991. The average of 5,677 was up nearly 5 percent. But combined handle for the season dropped 9 percent to an average of \$1.8 million daily; on-track wagering dipped 19 percent, to an average of \$555,436 per day. Tommy Turner led all jockeys with 62 wins to pick up his first Meadowlands riding title. Eddie Broome topped both the trainer and owners standings to earn his first Meadowlands titles with 19 victories.

Love Lock, who handed juvenile filly champ-elect Countess Diana her lone loss in the Gill Debutante S. at Churchill Downs in June, went 0-for-four after that score and was a distant ninth to that rival in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but came back to take the Gill Golden Rod S. in Louisville last out November 29. Returning to the West Coast, the grey filly was part of the entry sent off second choice but proved a 'mortal lock,' leading from gate to wire and winning as much the best. "When the doors opened, she left there like a Quarter horse," said winning jockey Kent Desormeaux. "She found herself lonely on the lead. From there she pretty much pulled herself up all the way to the quarter-pole. She's the kind of horse you like on the lead. She doesn't strain herself. She's like a bicycle. If you're not pedaling, she's not going." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who was winning his fourth consecutive Starlet, added, "Obviously, that wasn't her in the Breeders' Cup. I didn't have any explanation, but as you know, sometimes there isn't one. I had enough confidence in her to wheel her right back in the Kentucky race. I don't know what we'll do with her now. (Owner) Michael Tabor spends a lot of time in Florida, but they may let us keep her here. It's an awful good stakes schedule at Santa Anita." The 1-2 favorite Career Collection, runner-up in the Juvenile Fillies, was no match for the winner while clearly second best. "When the other horse got way from her, she may have gotten a little discouraged," said trainer Wally Dollase. "We sat too far back...if I had it to do over again, I would have let her run more the first half-mile. I don't know what we'll do next with her."
