MAYBE JACK ROMPS IN SUFFOLK MATCH

RACE Maybe Jack (Classic Account) wrested command from Pro on Ice (Distinctive Pro) at the top of the stretch and drew off to take the "Suffolk Showdown" by 9½ lengths, confirming his status as the nation's winningest horse of 1997. With 21/2 weeks left in the year, the two horses had been deadlocked at 12 wins apiece. "We wanted to pressure him (Pro on Ice) right from the start and that's how it worked out," said winning jockey Rudy Baez. "I was hoping Maybe Jack had something left turning for home because I had asked him a lot already." The winner paid \$3.00 to win. The Maybe Jack-Pro On Ice perfecta, which was essentially a second win pool in the two-horse race, paid \$2.40. The pair dueled side by side to the far turn, but Maybe Jack, racing over his home track and at his best distance, wore down the gray Finger Lakes sprinter for his 13th win of the year.

REMINGTON PARK ENDS '97 MEET Remington Park concluded its 1997 season yesterday. Exactly 900 races were contested during the season, highlighted by the ninth running of the \$300,000 Remington Park Derby. Frank Stronach's Wild Rush (Wild Again) invaded from California to capture the Aug. 10 cornerstone event of the meet. Total attendance at the 107-day meeting was 338,410 for a daily on-track average of 3,163. Jockey Tim Doocy secured his fourth title as leading rider with 127 victories, 48 more than runner-up Don Pettinger. Kenny Smith posted his second straight trainer's title at the Oklahoma track. Leading owner honors went to Champ Hinton, Jr.
