DOLLASE TO HANDLE THOROUGHBRED

CORP. STRING Conditioner Wally Dollase has been hired as private trainer for Prince Ahmed Salman's The Thoroughbred Corp. Dollase, who handled champion Jewel Princess (Key to the Mint) as well as graded-stakes winners Crafty Friend (Crafty Prospector) and Windsharp (Lear Fan) for the Prince, signed a three-year contract to train a stable of 30-plus horses for The Thoroughbred Corp. He will retain an additional 10 horses from outside clients, including Gl Travers and GI Super Derby winner Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister) and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and GI Hollywood Starlet runner-up Career Collection (General Meeting). D. Wayne Lukas, who has trained the majority of The Thoroughbred Corp.'s horses including MGISW Sharp Cat (Storm Cat), was offered the private position but had to decline. "The Prince wants a private trainer, and we tried to hire Wayne but he couldn't do it," Thoroughbred Corp. spokesman Richard Mulhall told the Daily Racing Form. "We would have loved to have had him but he's got the Lewises, Overbrook Farm, and (Michael) Tabor. We're happy with Wayne and he's done a great job." Dollase will move his base of operations from Hollywood Park to Santa Anita.

CRAIG PERRET WINS GEORGE WOOLF

AWARD Craig Perret, with an Eclipse Award, a Kentucky Derby and four Breeders' Cup races to his credit, has been honored with the 1998 George Woolf Memorial Jockey Award. The Woolf Award recognizes Thoroughbred jockeys whose careers have gained respect for both themselves and their sport. Perret was chosen for the award by his fellow riders; Russell Baze, Ruben Hernandez, Ray Sibille and Ron Warren Jr. were also nominated this year. A New Orleans native, Perret becomes the 49th recipient of the Woolf Award, which was named for the jockey who was killed in a racing accident at Santa Anita in 1946. "Of all the awards I've won, including the Eclipse, this will be my most emotional for me and have the deepest meaning because I was selected by my peers, the people I work and live with for more then eight hours a day," said Perret. "You can win a Derby or a Breeders' Cup, but this is different. It is an accumulation of your work over the years as measured by your peers." The award will be presented during a ceremony at Santa Anita during the track's 1997-98 season, which begins December 26.



Local News: Hong Kong

A new Hong Kong record price of HK\$3.6 million (\$465,415) was reached at the 1997 Hong Kong International Sale of two-year-olds at Sha Tin Saturday. The record was set when local owner Chan Chun-Ming came in with the bid for a colt by Royal Academy out of Ballet Classique (Sadler's Wells). A total of 23 two-year-olds were sold for HK\$21.85 million (\$2,824,822), an average of HK\$950,000 (\$122,818). Those figures were down from last year's auction, which grossed HK\$30 million (\$3,878,474) and averaged HK\$1,034,483 (\$133,740).


