**HOOSIER PARK WRAP-UP** Boosted by increased out-of-state wagering on its live card, the 1997 Hoosier Park Thoroughbred meet which ended November 29 showed gains in both total handle and daily average total handle, while attendance at the Indiana oval remained steady. A total of \$36,708,948 was wagered on-track, in-state and out-of-state during the 58-day Hoosier season, up 21.5 percent from 1996 when \$30,194,298 was handled on the track's 52 live cards. Daily average total handle was up 8.9 percent, from \$580,660 last year to \$632,913 in '97. Attendance during what was the track's third season of racing was 73,900, up from 65,750 in 1996. Despite suffering a fractured tibia in a spill November 10 which sidelined him for the remainder of the meeting, jockey Jon Court picked up his second straight Hoosier riding title with 65 victories. Earl Murphy topped all trainers with 18 wins, while his biggest client, Michael Bruder, led the owner standings with 12.

**VELASQUEZ TO CALL IT QUITS NEW YEAR'S EVE** Hall of Fame jockey Jorge Velasquez, who announced his retirement from riding last month, will close out his career at Calder Race Course Wednesday, December 31. Velasquez, 50, will fall about 200 wins shy of 7,000, a mark which has been reached by only five riders in history. A native of Panama, he came to the U.S. in 1965 and went on to a career which included wins in the Kentucky Derby, Preakness and two Breeders' Cup races, passing the \$100 million mark in purses in 1988. Calder will honor Velasquez with a ceremony in the winner's circle on New Year's Eve.

Panama City, a Group 3 winner at this distance in England and third in this year's G1 Italian Derby, was making his third Stateside start. Impressive winning a Churchill allowance test getting Lasix for the first time in his latest November 5, the bay was bet down to even-money. Last after a half, the crowd's choice found room to rally, splitting horses in the stretch to get through late for a narrow score. "He wasn't getting into the race early, but when we turned up the backstretch the field starting bunching up and coming back to us and he started getting a little aggressive," said winning rider Pat Day. "What I needed to do then was find him some space. We were inside and behind, and things had to break right. They did. He was all racehorse in the drive." The three-year-old will make his next start at the upcoming Gulfstream Park meet, which begins January 3.

Winner of the nine-furlong GIII Rare Treat H. over this track last February, Prophet's Warning returned from a five-month layoff October 23 to take an Aqueduct sprint allowance, but tired badly after chasing the pace in the GII Top Flight H. at a mile in her latest November 28 and finished eighth. Sent right to the lead in this mile-and-a-quarter test, the dark bay was pressed through moderate fractions but had plenty left to turn back the challenge of favored Mil Kilates in the final drive, then had to survive a claim of foul by jockey Mike Smith, aboard the runner-up. "I thought I was clear...we never made contact," said winning rider Jorge Chavez. "I felt good in the stretch, but it seemed like my horse was playing. She would go, then slow down, then when the other horse came she would go again." As for the future, trainer Joe Orseno said, "She may have one more start, but she is going to the breeding shed. She is going to be bred to Mr. Prospector." Prophet's Warning was purchased three weeks before this race, and gave new owner Jane Lyon her first starter and her first winner.

Added trainer William Morey, Jr., "I only slept four hours last night. This colt has me so nervous, but it's all worth it. It's what this game is all about."
