#### NOTHIN' LEICA DANE TO STUD IN

AUSTRALIA Australian dual Group 1 winner Nothin' Leica Dane (Aus) (Danehill) is in quarantine in France, getting ready to return to Australia where he will stand at Martin Hawcroft's Byerley Stud in New South Wales in 1998. Winner of the G1 Victoria Derby in November, 1995, he came back three days later and was runner-up in the Foster's Melbourne Cup. Nothin' Leica Dane lost his form in Australia last season and was shipped to France this year. He finished second in the G3 Prix Foy at Longchamp in September, but subsequently ran 17th in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and seventh in the G1 Prix Royal Oak and was retired. "Nothin' Leica Dane is sick of being a racehorse and some Australian breeders are tiring of shuttle stallions, so he will fill a niche," said part-owner Helen Dalton.

#### GROUP 1 WINNERS TO HARAS D'ETREHAM

Haras d'Etreham in Normandy, France will be home in 1998 to two French Group 1 winners, Grape Tree Road (Ire) (Caerleon) and Poliglote (GB) (Sadler's Wells). Racing in the colours of Michael Tabor and trained by Andre Fabre, Grape Tree Road earned his Group 1 status when producing an electrifying finish to take the 1996 Grand Prix de Paris. He will stand at Haras d'Etreham for a fee of 30,000 French francs (approximately \$5,060). Fiveyear-old Poliglote won the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud as a juvenile, was second in the Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) in 1995 and ran third in last year's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. Unsuccessful in three starts in California this year, he retires with a record of five wins, four seconds and three thirds from 19 starts and earnings of \$560,777. He will stand for a fee of 35,000 French francs (approximately \$5,900).

Refinado Tom (Arg) ended his Argentine career with four consecutive Grade 1 triumphs, finishing a sweep of his country's Triple Crown in the Argentina Derby in his final South American appearance November 9, 1996, but had failed to reach the winner's circle in three previous U.S. starts. Third, beaten only a neck, in the GIII William P. Kyne H. at Bay Meadows in September, the chestnut colt was most recently a tiring fifth in the mileand-a-sixteenth Arcangues H. at Hollywood November 16. The second choice here, he stalked pacesetter LE TRITON (El Gran Senor) for six furlongs before putting a head in front and galloping away from the field for an eye-catching tally. "It's been so disappointing with what I've gotten out of him up to here," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He injured his shoulder earlier in the year, but we've been working on that. I think today we turned the corner. He's obviously a good horse. It looks like it's finally paying off." Added jockey Gary Stevens, "I told Richard in the paddock, 'this is where we started the roll last year with Gentlemen (Arg). Maybe we can follow suit with this horse.' There's a lot to live up to, but you know when he came here, his reputation was a little stronger than what Gentlemen's was." The 8-5 favorite KUKULCAN (Cox's Ridge), winner of the GIII Laz Barrera H. last out, pressed the pace but had nothing left for the drive and finished fifth. "He didn't handle the track very good," said his rider, Alex Solis. "He was bouncing all over it." PERCUTANT (GB) (Perrault {GB}) lost contact with the field on the final bend and was eased. "When the pace quickened a little bit down the backside and I clucked to him, he tried to prop," said jockey Kent Desormeaux. "He's so mean. I feared for my life at that point."



Trainer Richard Mandella, who secured his fourth Hollywood Park training title with a win in yesterday's GIII Native Diver H., had more on his mind than titles this weekend. His 18-year-old daughter Andrea is in Ohio recovering from 8 ½ hours of surgery to repair a broken vertebra suffered in a car accident Tuesday. The surgery went well and the prognosis is good for Andrea, who has full movement. She is expected to fly to California this week. "In racing, we think it's so important what we're doing," said Mandella. "Believe me, nobody loves this sport more than I do, but when something like this happens, you realize this is just a game. The greatest victory in my life was (Andrea) coming out of surgery."

#### Local News: Australia

Le Destin (Fr) (Zayyani {Ire}) has been bought to race in Australasia, his main target being the 1998 Foster's Melbourne Cup. A winner of just one of 23 starts in France but Group 1 placed three times, the four-year-old was purchased by a syndicate headed by Gerard Peterson. Last year Peterson imported another French-trained runner, the Aga Khan's Group 2 winner Kassani, for the Melbourne Cup, only to see him break down a few weeks before the race; the colt had to be destroyed. Le Destin is at present in quarantine in Britain.
