SILVER CHARM SECOND IN COMEBACK Silver Charm (Silver Buck) returned to the races yesterday at Santa Anita for the first time since being denied the Triple Crown in the June 7 Belmont S., with a runner-up finish in the G1 Malibu S. The Kentucky Derby champion was made the prohibitive 1-5 favorite of the Opening Day crowd, but was plagued with traffic troubles before breaking lose at the eighth pole and just missed catching 9-1 outsider **Lord Grillo (Arg)** (Engrillado {Arg}). "I couldn't get through until too late," said Silver Charm's jockey Gary Stevens. "The winner's momentum was built up. We should have won by five." Trainer Bob Baffert echoed Stevens's assessment of the race and added, "He would have beaten them without the traffic problems. He showed some heart and he hasn't lost a competitive step." Baffert said the grey colt will start next in the January 17 GII San Fernando S.

TRIPLE CROWN NOMINATIONS DUE JAN. 17 The first deadline for nominations to the 1998 \$5 million Visa Triple Crown Challenge is January 17. The early fee is \$600 per horse nominated to the three races--the May 2 Kentucky Derby, the May 16 Preakness S. and the June 6 Belmont S. A late nomination period will close March 27. The entry fee during that period will be \$6,000 per horse. Representatives from Churchill Downs, Pimlico and Belmont Park will be at tracks around the country during a two-week period in January to take nominations. In addition, the racing offices at each of the Triple Crown tracks will accept nominations by phone or fax until midnight January 17. LEWISES RECEIVE ECLIPSE AWARD OF MERIT Bob and Beverly Lewis were named the recipients of the 1997 Eclipse Award of Merit yesterday. The couple, who celebrated 50 years of marriage in August, became ambassadors for the sport last spring when their three-year-old colt Silver Charm captured the public's imagination with wins in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. The Lewises also campaigned champion Serena's Song and owned a one-third interest in 1994's champion two-year-old Timber Country. Thoroughbred owners since 1990, the Lewis Stable now includes 45-50 horses in training, another 20 two-year-olds at farms and training centers in Kentucky and six broodmares, including Serena's Song, who is in foal to Mr. Prospector.

Lord Grillo (Arg) captured the June 16 G1 Carrera de las Estrellas in his native Argentina before finishing second in a Nov. 22 optional claimer in his United States debut. Third choice behind the heavily favored Silver Charm, Lord Grillo, off slowly, raced in eighth early, rallied five wide turning for home, overtook Swiss Yodeler in deep stretch and then gamely held off Silver Charm to the wire. "My wife told me, 'If you beat Silver Charm, the fans are going to be mad at you,'" winning owner Gary Biszantz said. "I said, 'I don't mind beating Baffert ever. I love him, but I don't mind beating him. He's beaten me enough in the past.' I was worried that seven furlongs wasn't far enough for him, that he's really a mile or a mile-and-a-quarter horse. He really made up a lot of ground today." Winning jockey Eddie Delahoussaye had nothing but praise for his mount. "I didn't know if we could beat Silver Charm, but this horse just cut when I called on him. He's got a lot of class, this little horse. He doesn't worry about anything. I never did see Silver Charm during the race. The only time I heard Silver Charm was when I heard (track announcer) Trevor Denman say his name." The first two finishers will meet up again in the second leg of the Strub Series, the January 17 GII San Fernando S.

ALWAYS FAIR TO PRESTONWOOD Multiple group stakes winner **Always Fair** (Danzig--Carduel {Buckpasser}) will stand the 1998 breeding season at Prestonwood Farm in Versailles, Kentucky. The 12-year-old stallion formerly stood at stud in France. As a two-year-old, he captured the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot, at three he won the G3 Prix Quincey at Deauville, and he placed second in four other graded events during his career. **Always Fair** was represented by six stakes winners from his first crop, including Group winners **Vadlawys** and **Lunafairy**. The property of a syndicate, **Always Fair** will stand for a 1998 stud fee of \$6,000 live foal, due November 1.
