JOCKEY WARREN MEHRTENS DEAD Jockey Warren Mehrtens, who guided Assault to victory in the 1946 Triple Crown, died Tuesday in Sarasota, Florida, according to a report in the *Daily Racing Form*. He was 77. At the conclusion of his 12-year riding career, Mehrtens served as a steward for The Jockey Club and as an official of the New York Racing Association.

AQUEDUCT OPENS '98 SEASON THURSDAY Aqueduct opens its 64-day winter meet tomorrow with the \$75,000 Gill Interborough H. highlighting the first 1998 racing card. Headlining the stakes schedule are the Gill Distaff H. for older fillies and mares on March 14, the Gill Withers S. for three-year-old going one mile on May 2 and the May 3 GI Carter H. over seven furlongs for three-year-olds and up. For three-year-olds on the Triple Crown path, the New York track features the \$150,000 Gill Gotham at one mile on March 21 and the nine-furlong \$500,000 Gill Wood Memorial April 11. Aqueduct will be dark on Mondays and Tuesdays, with the exception of January 19 (Martin Luther King, Jr. Day) and Monday, February 16 (President's Day). There will be no racing on Wednesday, January 21 or Wednesday, February 18. The meet concludes on March 29.

RACING RETURNS TO SUFFOLK TOMORROW Live racing returns to Suffolk Downs tomorrow with a special New Year's Day program. The East Boston track will run its 97-day meeting on a four-day weekly schedule through March with dark days on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Starting in April, Fridays will be added to the lineup through the final day of racing, June 6. The highlight of the season will be the 59th Massachusetts H. on May 30. The Grade III event has been won in recent years by two-time Horse of the Year Cigar ('95 and '96) and champion Skip Away ('97). The opening day feature is the Floyd Duncan S. for older fillies and mares sprinting six furlongs.

Ecoute took a listed stake in France before winning her American debut in a Del Mar allowance race last August. Winless in three starts since, the filly was coming off of a fifth-place effort in the Dec. 14 GII Dahlia H. at Hollywood. The favorite set the pace from the start and enjoyed a clear lead for much of the race before holding off third choice Angel Face for her first American stakes win. "Today, going a mile-and-a-quarter seemed the right distance for her," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "She acts like she might even go on a little (in distance) because she's so one-paced. She's solid right around there, which is why you didn't see any horses able to catch her in the last eighth-of-a-mile."
