SUNDAY RACING CANCELLATIONS Live racing at Aqueduct Racetrack, Turfway Park and Suffolk Downs was cancelled yesterday due to inclement weather. The closings marked the second straight day both Turfway and Suffolk were forced to call off racing, New York Racing Association officials cited heavy rains and high winds as the reason for cancelling the Aqueduct card. Seven-eighths of an inch of rain fell in a half-hour period during the morning, causing water to back up in the paddock and on the track. Cold temperatures and icy conditions kept the horses indoors at Turfway, while heavy sleet and

freezing rain prevented Suffolk from staging a card.

MAGIC MILLIONS SALE STARTS FRIDAY A host of Northern Hemisphere shuttle stallions will be represented at the 1999 four-day Honda Magic Millions yearling sales on Australia's Gold Coast, beginning Friday, Jan. 8. Among the American-based sires with representatives at the 700-lot sale are: Brocco (12 yearlings), Cryptoclearance (1), Dehere (20), Eagle Eyed (9), Housebuster (7), Lure (2), Mister Frisky (1), Personal Hope (6), Prized (1), Quest for Fame (GB), Regal Classic (9), Rhythm (3), Sky Classic (1), Supremo (7) and Thunder Gulch (11). Graduates of the Magic Millions yearling sales qualify for two \$1 million races (US\$616,789), one for two-year-olds at six furlongs on the Gold Coast and the other for three-year-olds at 7 1/2 furlongs at Rosehill in Sydney, as well as for a \$500,000 (US\$308,394) all-aged race at seven furlongs in Queensland.


