ECLIPSE FINALISTS NAMED Awesome Again

(Deputy Minister), **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) and **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) are the three finalists for the title of 1998 Horse of the Year, it was announced yesterday. The trio are also on the short list for champion older horse honors. Finalists in 11 equine Eclipse Award categories as well as top owner, trainer, jockey and apprentice jockey have been released, with three contestants still alive in each division except two-year-old filly and three-year-old filly, in which only two horses received votes. The winners will be revealed at the 28th Annual Eclipse Awards Dinner at the Sheraton Bal Harbour Hotel in Miami Tuesday, Feb. 16. The winner of the Eclipse Award of Merit will be announced Feb. 9.

TURFWAY'S HOLIDAY MEET SHOWS GAINS

Turfway Park's 20-day 1998 Holiday Meet, which ran from Nov. 29-Dec. 31, showed increases in on-track, out-of-state and total handle. Average on-track wagering was \$462,118, up 7.2 percent from 1997, while the total handle averaged \$3,886,727 daily, a gain of 8.8 percent over last year. The biggest increase came in out-of-state handle which averaged \$1,862,145 daily, up 15.4 percent. On-track attendance was also on the rise, averaging 1,677 a day, up 1.5 percent from '97. "Full fields (averaging 9.5 starters per race) and the lowest takeout in the country are selling with our customers," said Turfway President Mark Simendinger. "Our out-of-state increase is most gratifying as it shows we are being selected in the national marketplace. Our on-track handle increase in the face of severe riverboat competition in the Greater Cincinnati area is also a positive sign."

INCURABLE OPTIMIST POINTS TO IRISH 2000

GUINEAS? Incurable Optimist (Cure the Blues), the top three-year-old grass horse in the country, is being strongly considered for the May 22 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh, trainer Dave Donk said yesterday. The same race was won by fellow New York-bred Fourstars Allstar in 1991. "The Irish 2000 Guineas could be his Kentucky Derby," Donk said. "It's a Group 1 race, and a win by him could enhance all of us involved. Everything would have to fall into place, but it's something we're going to give strong consideration to." Incurable Optimist has not started since winning the Nov. 28 GIII Generous S. at Hollywood Park, which improved his record on the grass to four-for-four. He had his first workout since that race yesterday, going three furlongs at Hialeah. According to Donk, he went in :38 3/5. Incurable Optimist is scheduled to have his three-yearold debut in the Everglades S. at Hialeah.
