TOMORROWS CAT TO QUESTROYAL Grade II stakes winner Tomorrows Cat (Storm Cat--Tomorrow's Child, by Al Nasr {Fr}) has arrived at Questroyal Stud in New Hampton, New York. In 15 starts, the four-year-old won four races, was second four times, third twice and earned \$516,090. Last summer under the care of trainer Mark Hennig, he finished a a head behind Favorite Trick in the Long Branch S. at Monmouth Park, was runner-up in the GIII Pennsylvania Derby and won the GII Pegasus S. at the Meadowlands. Sent to trainer Bob Baffert after his Pegasus score, Tomorrows Cat won a Churchill allowance but sustained a career-ending injury in the GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita. Almost fully syndicated, he will stand this season for a fee of \$10,000 live foal.




