"WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP OF RACING"

ANNOUNCED According to Friday's Hong Kong Standard, a "World Championship of Racing" involving eight races in seven countries could be a reality as soon as March 2000, if a sponsor for the event can be found. Eight organizations have signed on to participate in the series, which would begin with the Dubai World Cup, followed by the King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. in England, Ireland's Champion S., Australia's Cox Plate, Woodbine's Canadian International, the Arlington Million and Breeders' Cup Mile in the U.S., and finally the Hong Kong International Cup in December. With Arlington International currently on hiatus, the Million could be moved to another venue until racing returns to the Chicago track. The distance of the Hong Kong race, the only stakes in the series which is not a Group/Grade I, would be extended from 1,800 to 2,000 meters and could be changed as soon as the year. A point system would determine the champion at the end of the series. Hong Kong Jockey Club chief executive Lawrence Wong told the Standard that the championship could be expanded to include other countries on the approval of 75 percent of the founding members, with Japan and France most likely to join. "It's an exciting idea, but it all depends on getting a global sponsor," Wong was quoted in the Standard. "Without one, we will have to return to the drawing boards."

SILVER CHARM TOPS DONN WEIGHTS Silver Charm (Silver Buck) will give from six to 16 pounds to his rivals in the \$500,000 GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Jan. 30. The five-year-old has been assigned 126 pounds for the race, six more than Puerto Madero (Chi) (Gallantsky) and Sir Bear (Sir Leon), who are also pointing for the 1 1/8-mile race. The expected field of 10 also includes Frisk Me Now (Mister Frisky), 117; Crypto Star (Cryptoclearance), 114; Behrens (Pleasant Colony), 113; Unruled (Notebook) and Early Warning (Summer Squall), 112; Truluck (Conquistador Cielo), 111; and Hanarsaan (Hansel), 110. Trainer Richard Mandella confirmed he is sending R. D. Hubbard's Puerto Madero east for the race. "He worked this morning, going seven-eighths in 1:27 1/5," said Mandella from Santa Anita. "It was an easy work. We didn't want to blow his tires off before the big race. We called for a plane and we're leaving on Tuesday." Silver Charm arrives from California on the same plane.

Seven-length winner of last year's seven-furlong GI Ballerina H., Stop Traffic had her '98 campaign interrupted by no less than five short layoffs. Third in the Sept. 19 GI Ruffian H. going a mile and a sixteenth after her Ballerina triumph, she was then off for seven weeks before running third in Churchill's Abrogate H. CANADIAN CHAMP TO STONERSIDE STABLE

Primaly (Alydeed), Canada's champion two-year-old filly of 1997 and runner-up in last year's Canadian Oaks, heads of trio of horses purchased by Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Stable in three separate transactions last week. Primaly, who was purchased from breeder Kinghaven Farms and came back after a sixmonth layoff to take a Gulfstream allowance test by 5 1/4 lengths Jan. 1, and Delivery (Arg) (Political Ambition), a four-year-old filly who has won three of five starts--including a pair of Grade 1 races--in her native country, will join the Stonerside racing stable. Primaly runs in today's GIII Sabin H. for trainer Roger Attfield, and then transfers to the barn of trainer Pat Byrne. Delivery is scheduled to ship from South America to trainer Bob Baffert's barn in California today. Stonerside has also acquired the four-year-old filly Star Of Broadway (Broad Brush--Meteor Miner, by Mr. Prospector), who has been retired and likely will be bred to Seattle Slew. She won four of her 11 career starts, numbering the '98 GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland among her successes, and earned \$229,377.

In 1997, trainer Lou Goldfine sent out a then unknown allowance horse named Wild Event to win the GII Arlington H. in his first-ever stakes appearance. Lightning struck again in the Canadian Turf H. Federal Trial, bred along the same lines as Skip Away, broke his maiden Aug. 22 on the main track in Chicago, then returned from a layoff to contest three grassy allowances, with a pair of second-place finishes and a convincing victory in his most recent effort, a front-running 5 3/4-length tally at Churchill Downs Nov. 26. Still, a victory in this race would be asking a lot, considering the presence of GI Hollywood Derby winner Vergennes (Dynaformer) and a host of other proven turf veterans. Federal Trial broke alertly and forced the early pace, eventually gaining a short lead with about a 1/2 mile to run. As the field rounded into the stretch, the gelding maintained a narrow margin, was able to withstand a fresh challenge from Vergennes at the eighth pole and inched clear to the final margin of victory. Deep Dive, bumped at the outset, closed ground late to be second. "I had him entered in an allowance race last Saturday, but when it rained and they took the race off the turf, I scratched him," said Goldfine. The winner could resurface in the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 6, although Goldfine indicated he would prefer to run Wild Event in that spot.
