In other Donn news, 1998 Louisiana and Arkansas Derby hero Crypto Star (Cryptoclearance) went five furlongs in 1:02 handily at Hialeah yesterday morning. "We're on the fence right now but we're definetly leaning toward running him in the Donn," said trainer Larry Kelly. "It was an excellent move and the last time I will work him before the race." If he does start, Crypto Star will be ridden by Robbie Davis, who rode him to a Gulfstream allowance victory in his most recent start.

The operation, performed by Dr. Greg Ferraro at Santa Anita, was to speed the healing process of the colt's left front cannon bone. "Dr. Ferraro was happy with how the surgery went," said Morey. "We can walk the colt. On May 1, we'll x-ray him again and if everything's OK, he'll start jogging. Hopefully, he'll be back racing in September." This was the second time Dixie Dot Com suffered a hairline fracture of the left front cannon bone.

I hope to win the Kentucky Derby. She'll run all day long." Honest Lady will make her next start in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 13.
